M & M's

As we celebrate the 55th anniversary of the Catholic Church in the Cayman Islands we should be proud of the accomplishments that the Catholic Church has made here. Three Churches on our Islands, one of the best schools on Grand Cayman, and probably the largest single congregation of any of the religions here on the islands. All within 55 years. That is a great accomplishment. Although our congregation is represented by many nationalities, we have been gaining families native here to the Cayman Islands over the last 10 years especially by our RCIA program. But the best accomplishment of the Catholic Church is the dedication of its parishioners. All of you have been faithful and determined to make the Catholic Church your community, your home, your place to meet and gather. This is what makes up a good Christian community. People sharing their lives, their sorrows, their joys, their resources to help one another live together on a relatively small amount of space.

One year ago we had a devastating weekend. Hurricane Ivan at first seemed to have destroyed everything that had been built up on these islands. Homes were destroyed, businesses were damaged and some totally lost, plane loads of families, spouses and children left the islands to live somewhere else. Schools were delayed and challenged as to how to get in a full year. But the island worked hard, and worked together. There is still so much work to be done. But we are moving now from rebuilding, to once again building anew.

As a Catholic Community here in the Cayman Islands, we also must look toward building anew. How can we make our community even better? What do we need to do to be better examples of Christians to our non-Catholic brothers and sisters? How can we work together to make the city of God a reality in our community? Just because we have rebuilt does not mean that we stop and relax. Jesus tells us that the work of the Kingdom of God is never finished. And we know we do not have an ideal community here. It will continue to take all our effort, all our love, all our forgiveness to continue God's work here in the Cayman Islands.

This past week, we have been reminded of the power of nature that hit us last year with Ivan, and now has devastated areas along the Gulf Coast with Katrina. Many Catholic Parishes and Schools have been wiped out by the hurricane. Many have no idea where their congregation has even gone. For many it will take more than a year to rebuild some of what they had. Our collections on this weekend of our 55th anniversary will go to help the Catholic Churches and schools along the Gulf Coast. We might not be able to rebuild a whole church or school, but what we give can help, along with all the other parishes throughout the world sharing their resources, to begin to rebuild in that area. God has blessed us here on these islands and hopefully we will be able to see the blessings God gives to those along the Gulf Coast in a year.

Thank you to all those who have taken so much time and effort to plan and put that plan into action for this weekend. So many of you worked so very hard to show your love and care for this community. Hopefully many more of you will choose to put your faith into action within our Catholic Community to make this place your home.
