A hearty thank you to the choir and musicians of Christ the Redeemer and St. Ignatius for the music, and a great thank you to all those who put together the brunch of nations. Your work in providing food from your nationalities was really great and the hall looked tremendous. I have to say that not only was the mass great but the food served after was even better. We needed a hall twice the size for all the people that joined in for the lunch, but it was a great way to "rub shoulders" with all the parishioners. I also want to thank Nancy from Vigoro Nursery who supplied the plants for the tent and Jo-Anne from Celebrations who supplied the Eucharist Backdrop for the hall, and Menino from Guard on Alert who supplied the security throughout Saturday night and Sunday morning. Also a thank you to all the ushers and maintenance who helped set up the tent and take it down. The Tent was given to us to use by Pastor Jeffrey Thompson of the Seventh Day Adventist Church. A great big thank you to them and their willingness to share their tent. To all the servers a big thanks, it was great to see so many of you there and helping out. And a big thank you to all of you for showing up, filling the tent, singing so beautifully, and giving praise to God for all that He has done for us over the last 55 years and especially during the last year.
