M & M's

Today we hear Jesus using some very fierce words saying that sinners are entering heaven in greater numbers than those who are considered holy and spiritual. Jesus is talking about priests and elders who are like the individual who outwardly says, "Yes!" to God, yet doesn't really do God's work. The sinners are like the individual who says, "No!" to God, yet does the best he or she can in any situation.

Which individual are you more like? Are you more likely to say you'll do something, and then not do it? Or are you more likely to say no to doing something but later do what was asked anyway? Or do you do both? Do you respond at work in the same way as you do at home, or differently? How are you at work? Are you more likely to say yes and not do the task, or are you more likely to say no but then do the work anyway? What might Jesus be saying to you with this parable? Think on these things and try to cite some examples.

The new year for Religious Education in our parish started with a blast last weekend. It was great to see many new faces and many children/teenagers returning with a lot of excitement to learn about Jesus Christ. However it was a bit disappointing not seeing a number of children returning especially some of those who have made their First Communion over the last couple of years and specifically this past June. There seems to be a trend for parents promising to take children to Mass and Communion classes and after receiving the Sacrament, they disappear. The same is true for Baptism. Parents and Godparents promise faithfully that they will raise the children in the faith but they are not seen until they are aged 7 for First Communion preparation. I encourage all parents and Godparents, especially those with children who do not attend St. Ignatius Prep School to ensure that your child or Godchild is continually attending Religious Education classes. The parish and catechists have invested a lot of their time, talent and resources in order to make these programs available to you.

Below is a list of Religious Education programs that are available:

- Sunday School Classes for Kg through Year 6 students who do not attend St. Ignatius School
- First Communion Classes for all children who are age 7 or older and in Year 3. Must have completed Year 2 of Catholic Religious Education whether at St. Ignatius School or at Sunday School. Pre-Confirmation Classes for Year 7 High School students are on Saturdays at 4:00pm. Confirmation classes for students in Years 8 and 9 are also on Saturdays at 4:00pm.
- Friday Night Youth Meetings are at 6pm in the Loyola Hall. They are mainly for High Students.
- Sunday Evening Youth for teenagers who have been Confirmed are held weekly at 4pm at St. Ignatius.
- Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) are held every Tuesday at St. Ignatius Church. These classes are for Adults who are interested in becoming Catholics or adults who have not yet been confirmed or made First Holy Communion.

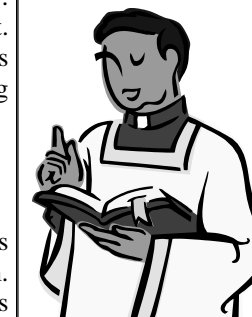

Why Go To Church?

A Church-goer wrote a letter to the editor of the newspaper and complained that
