### M & M's

As we enter October we are reminded that it is the month of the Holy Rosary. If you are not yet a regular attendee in the Adoration Chapel, why not start now? This would be a great time to visit the Blessed Sacrament and pray the Rosary. This is a beautiful way to spend an hour each week. It doesn't matter if you are 15 or 35, 55 or 75, the Lord has something for everyone! Give it a try! You will probably enjoy it so much that you will be signing up for a regular slot!

As you will have noted in the bulletin a couple of weeks ago our parish raised a fantastic total of CI\$17,782 towards the Hurricane Katrina relief efforts during our anniversary celebrations. This money has been forwarded to Catholic Charities and will be used in some of the affected areas. Our school students and staff also wanted to contribute in some way. During a recent non-uniform day, a further CI\$1751 was raised. This money has been forwarded to two St. Ignatius graduates, Karen Tomlinson and Claire Rohleder. These wonderful young ladies attend Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge. They have been volunteering in some of the outlying areas that have not been getting much attention. They will be using the funds to support families and school children with such items as baby clothes, diapers, school supplies, toiletries, and especially school uniforms. They will be taking photographs of all the purchases so that our students can see how the money was spent. In addition, over the past three weeks, the families of St. Ignatius School have donated more than 160 school bags and supplies! The bags have been sorted and boxed this week and will be flown up in the near future, where they will be distributed to one of the hard-hit Catholic schools in the New Orleans area. It is impressive to see the fabulous response from our parishioners, parents, teachers and students.

Many thanks indeed to the individuals who have made contributions to the scholarship fund. We have made up some of the shortfall, but we still have a long way to go. If anyone else would like to assist, donations are always gratefully accepted throughout the year. Please contact Michelle at the church office or myself at the school if you can help.

Many thanks to Fr. Alphonsus for his ministry here over the last two weeks and we wish him well as he returns to Jamaica. Thanks also to Fr. Paul Abbass for filling in over the past week and for leading a spiritual reflection for our teachers on Friday afternoon.

Mr. Miller and I have been delighted to see so many young people showing up to our Friday evening youth programme. We have had 67 in attendance (11-15 year-olds) each of the past two weeks. The monthly youth calendars (on coloured paper) are always available in the magazine rack at the church entrance.

In today's second reading (Philippians 4: 6-9) St. Paul writes some of the most beautiful words in the entire Bible. Give yourself a gift this week. Take a few quiet minutes, sit down and read these verses again. Then imagine if every person could strive to live by those words...
