I hope that you all enjoyed having Fr. Bill Russell, SJ with us here last week. In the few days that he was here with me we had a pretty good time and he has some great stories to tell. I always find it very enriching to be able to spend some time with the older clergy who have had some great experiences in parishes and throughout their lives as priests. Thanks for being so kind to him and to all the priests that visit us.

Our Confirmation Class is looking for a place to hold a retreat here on the Island. They would like to have the retreat on the weekend of February 3rd through the 5th. The problem is that we have no where to take about 25 teenagers and adults for a weekend. If you might have a place that has at least 4 bedrooms and a large room that they can gather in for their sessions preferably out in the Eastern End of the Island or along the water but someplace that is fairly quiet we would be happy to rent it for the retreat. The teens will bring their own airbeds or air mattresses so we don't need a place with 25 beds but enough bedrooms to separate the boys and the girls and for the priest to have a place to sleep. Please let me or Mr. O'Neil Miller know if you have an idea of what we might be able to use.

Speaking of houses, I am also looking for a place to buy here on the island. Even with hurricane Ivan messing up so many places along the water, I am interested in buying a small home or condo on the water somewhere near the parish here in George Town. If you have a place that you are thinking of selling and could offer me a good deal let me know. I've only owned one piece of property before, I bought my mother and dad's mobile home when they could not afford it but then sold it after both of them died. Now I am interested in finding a home again that I can call mine and am seriously considering buying something here on the island.

We are very blessed to have so many people coming to the Novena in honor of Mary this week. I have asked people to have one of their intentions for the Novena to pray for peace in the Middle East, especially in Iraq and in Israel. The wars there and throughout the Middle East are a serious problem and are really affecting the whole world. If nothing else we need to pray that peace between Muslims, Arabs, Jews, Palestinians and Christians can be worked out so that all can live in peace. I am very aware that it is the USA that seems to cause most of this trouble and we need to pray that the whole world will begin to try to solve this problem or the whole world may be in real danger. Come and pray with us if you can from 7:pm to 8:pm for peace through December 8th.

## Dear Padre? Is cremation permitted in the Church?

I heard that cremation is acceptable now? Does one just take the ashes to the Church?

### Dear Leo,

It is true that the Church does permit cremation now, but she does not encourage it. The preferred way to honor the body, which housed the soul, after death is burial or entombment. The body is normally brought to the Church for the funeral rites and then taken to the grave or the tomb.

Cremation is permitted when there is no intention to deny the resurrection of the body.

Sometimes there are good reasons for cremation and the Church recognizes this. In the case of cremation, it is preferred that the body be brought to the Church for the funeral rites and the cremation take place later.

The best source of information on how the funeral rites take place when there is cremation is the local parish or your diocese. Most dioceses have rules about funeral rites as they relate to cremated remains. In some places it may be the custom to bring the ashes to the Church, but this is not true everywhere. If you are facing such a situation, check with your local pastor. He should be able to guide you in planning a funeral when there is a cremation.

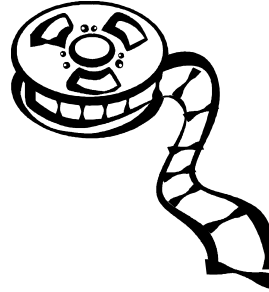
