Every year we get hundreds of calls asking for mass times from some of you who are at church each week. Also if you can share this information with any condo's or on a bulletin board at an apartment complex it would be appreciated.

I want to thank so many of you who have shared in the 9 day Novena in honor of Our Blessed Mother. There was nearly a hundred people each evening. That is a real blessing for the parish and a sign of our community gathering in prayer. May the blessings received from the Novena guide us as we continue to prepare for Christmas.

Gaudete in Domino semper! "Rejoice in the Lord always!" This is the entrance antiphon for today, the Third Sunday of Advent. This does not mean that we should cheer up and shout "Happy Holidays." The rejoicing St. Paul talks about is a deep down thing and the context is the proclamation from the prophet Isaiah: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me ... he has sent me to bring glad tidings to the poor, to heal the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and release to the prisoners..."

To rejoice we don't just "endure the holidays," but to realize that Christ knows our pains and whose promise is not to take that pain away or distract us from it or numb us so we don't feel it. His promise is that our suffering is the very stuff of which the kingdom is made. Remember, "Blessed are those who mourn ..." We enter into these last weeks before Christmas in a way that focuses on the suffering in our midst, calling us to realize that the "Lord is with us." The readings, the music, the prayers all take on a deeper meaning. With your eyes opened to the suffering, you will notice others who are hurting also, and you can pray for them. You are not alone.

St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund

Many thanks to those who have made contributions this year! The annual fees at St. Ignatius average about \$6000 per student. The scholarship fund tries to cover about twenty percent of this for needy families. Last year we assisted more than 40 children with about CI\$30,000 total. In return for the help, the families must volunteer to work at school events during the term and the students must maintain high standards of behaviour and academic progress.

Unfortunately, due to the after-effects of Hurricane Ivan, the fund is running very low. Donations are down and it has been very difficult to do any major fund-raising over the past year. At the same time, costs all over the island have risen dramatically, and many families who never previously applied for assistance are now coming forward. In the past three months we now have five additional families on a waiting list to receive assistance if it becomes available.

Any assistance is always gratefully received. What a wonderful Christmas present it could be to make a donation that would help a child's education! Any cheques should be made payable to ST.
