### MARRIAGE PREPARATION CLASSES FOR MARCH 2006

Usually the classes are on two Saturdays in a row, but because of special circumstances we will have to have it two days in a row. The next class is not until October 2006. All couples getting married in the Catholic Church must have a pre-marriage class. So if you are getting married during this year 2006, please register for these classes.

In our scripture readings for today, this second Sunday of Ordinary Time, we hear of the call of Samuel and some of the disciples. Like Samuel, it often takes time to recognize God's voice. Sometimes it is because God's voice is unexpected. Or because there are many other voices. Both the passage from 1 Samuel and the Gospel remind us that other people are often instrumental in helping us recognize and listen to God. In Samuel's case, he needed blind Eli to help him hear. In Peter's case, he needed his brother Andrew to lead him to Christ. Both great leaders responded to God with the help of someone else. Jesus' invitation to "come and see" was simple and direct. Something powerful and mysterious must have drawn the disciples to him. They were willing to go in a new direction, without quite understanding what that might be.

We can hear God's call in the needs of those around us. God calls us when a community needs help in a project, when a child asks for a glass of water, and when an older person needs a visit. God's call is often ordinary and simple. In what ways do you help members of this parish hear God's voice? How do we help children discover their unique gifts? Who are the Elis and Andrews of our parish who guide other toward Christ?

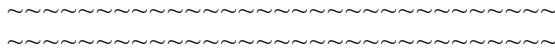

## St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund

Many thanks to those who have made contributions this year! The annual fees at St. Ignatius average about \$6000 per student. The scholarship fund tries to cover about twenty percent of this for needy families. last year we assisted more than 40 children with about CI\$30,000 total. In return for the help, the families must volunteer to work at school events during the term and the students must maintain high standards of behavior and academic progress.

Unfortunately, due to the after-effects of Hurricane Ivan, the fund is running very low. Donations are down and it has been very difficult to do any major fund-raising over the past year. At the same time, costs all over the island have risen dramatically, and many families who never previously applied for assistance are now coming forward. In the past three months we now have five additional families on a waiting list to receive assistance if it becomes available.

Any assistance is always gratefully received. What a wonderful Christmas present it could be to make a donation that would help a child's education! Any cheques should be made payable to ST.
