## M & M's

Next weekend we celebrate my 30th anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood. I think this 30 years has gone much faster than the 28 before I was ordained. It has been a blessed 30 years and I cannot think of anything else that I would rather have been doing or that I would want to do for a vocation. Although I had my sights set on flying jets when I was younger, sharing in the priesthood of Jesus Christ has brought me much closer than jet flying could ever do. Although you might physically soar high when flying a jet, I have had many more highs and soaring close to heaven than I believe I could ever have had as a pilot. So I am very happy about the call of God that I heard and responded to. Most of the highs have all been because of all of you, the parishioners and friends that I have been so privileged to share my ministry with. Without any of you it would have been a hermetic life and no where near as enjoyable. I look forward to the 8:30 mass next Sunday here at St. Ignatius celebrating my anniversary and the reception afterward. I hope that my ministry has been and will continue to be a blessing for you.

(From the instruction by the Bishop for the Ordination of a priest)

"...Let your instruction serve as a nourishing diet for the people of God. Let the impact of your life please the followers of Christ, so that by word and action you may strengthen the house which is the Church of God. In the same way you must carry our your ministry which will make the spiritual sacrifices of the faithful perfect by uniting them to the eucharistic sacrifice of Christ. That sacrifice of Christ will be offered sacramentally in an unbloody way through your hands. Understand the meaning of what you do; put into practice what you celebrate... In baptizing men and women you will bring them into the peoples of God; in the sacrament of penance you will forgive sins in the name of Christ and Church; with holy oil you relieve and console the sick. You will celebrate the liturgy, offer thanks and praise to God, praying for the people of God and the whole world as well..."

That is only part of the instruction but I take the above very seriously. Of all the ministry I do, sharing in the Eucharist with you is always the highlight of my day. Thank you for your support and cooperation in our building up of the Church of God.

Both the second reading and the Gospel today speak of the mission of preaching the Gospel. The first reading does not mention preaching, but it illustrates clearly the need for good news to be preached to those who find life burdensome. Jesus say that preaching the good news is the reason he came, a mission more important than even the healing he was working in Capernaum. Paul says that he has been given an obligation to preach, whether he does it willingly or unwillingly. I have found over these past 30 years that, for the most part, I love to preach the Word of God. Taking the time to prepare and reflect on the Word of God is a part of every day for me. Reading the scriptures every day, reflecting on them, taking the time to read the commentaries that tell of the history of that section of Scripture and reading others thoughts on that same Scripture helps in putting together my thoughts and ideas for preaching each day and each weekend. Sometimes I wish I had more time on Sundays and Saturdays to preach longer but usually I find that after 15 minutes I am mostly repeating myself and then that gets boring. I thank those of you who have commented on my preaching and my style of celebrating the Eucharist. Some comments are very helpful and others help me to focus in better on what the Lord is calling me to say. But whether I want to preach or do not want to preach, I am compelled, like St. Paul, to preach any way. I pray that my preaching gets better with age and years of practice.

## St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund

Many thanks to those who have made contributions this year! The annual fees at St. Ignatius average about \$6000 per student. The scholarship fund tries to cover about twenty percent of this for needy families. last year we assisted more than 40 children with about CI\$30,000 total. In return for the help, the families must volunteer to work at school events during the term and the students must maintain high standards of behavior and academic progress.

Unfortunately, due to the after-effects of Hurricane Ivan, the fund is running very low. Donations are down and it has been very difficult to do any major fund-raising over the past year. At the same time, costs all over the island have risen dramatically, and many families who never previously applied for assistance are now coming forward. In the past three months we now have five additional families on a waiting list to receive assistance if it becomes available.

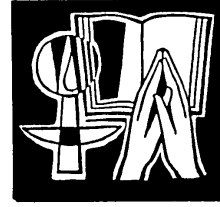
