**This week Cardinal Adam Maida will be coming to our parish here in the Cayman Islands. After Hurricane Ivan, Cardinal Maida promised us that he would visit us again. This is his first chance to be with us since then. In between Ivan and now Cardinal Maida was also a part of the conclave who chose our new Pope, Benedict the XVI. At the 8:30 Sunday liturgy, Cardinal Maida will celebrate confirmation for our young people in our parish who have been preparing extensively these last two years to receive this sacrament. I am not sure how many other masses he will celebrate next weekend but I am sure that he will be around to greet as many of you as possible. Most often you greet a cardinal with YOUR EMINENCE, or Cardinal Maida. (His last name is pronounced as if the a was not there ex: Mida, with a long i) The priest with him is Msgr. Kasza, the Cardinal's secretary. It will be good to have him here with us once again. As I mentioned before, the Cardinal is celebrating his 50th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood this June.**

**As I celebrate my 30th anniversary I want to thank all of you who have made a special effort to pray for me and offer me congratulations. This is a wonderful vocation and I have loved every minute of it. If there are any young men thinking about being a priest, I encourage you to not only pray about it but seriously think about going to the seminary either in Detroit or where ever else you might feel comfortable and spend a weekend with other men who are considering and looking at this great vocation. The Church is in great need of both young men and women who might be hearing the call to serve the Lord with all that we have. Don't let that call pass you by.**

**Tuesday is Valentine's Day and I want to wish you all a blessed and joyful day to celebrate the love we have for each other and to remember that our greatest valentine comes from God himself who gave his His son, Jesus Christ, as the real sign of love to our whole world. I hope Tuesday will be a great day of loving one another.**

**In our Gospel today, Jesus heals a man with leprosy but reaching out and touching him. This Gospel calls us to reflect on how often we might avoid those who make us squeamish. The neurotic neighbor or family member; the nonstop talker, odd dresser or hand-wringing obsessive personality who elicits from us a little eye-rolling and not much more. Persons with almost any kind of disability tend to make us uneasy. Like the leper in today's Gospel, when the miracle that God has touched us hits home, we can't keep it to ourselves. If we choose to respond by offering a healing hand to others, we are free to do so just as we are. People who have been powerfully touched still have their imperfections. And each of us have some imperfections that need healing. We all are invited to be "healers" to those whom no one else wants to touch, for whatever reason. Let us ask for the grace to reach out to all in need with the healing touch of compassion and love.**

## St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund

Many thanks to those who have made contributions this year! The annual fees at St. Ignatius average about \$6000 per student. The scholarship fund tries to cover about twenty percent of this for needy families. last year we assisted more than 40 children with about CI\$30,000 total. In return for the help, the families must volunteer to work at school events during the term and the students must maintain high standards of behavior and academic progress.

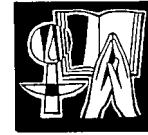

At the same time, costs all over the island have risen dramatically, and many families who never previously applied for assistance are now coming forward.
