### PARISH LENTEN RETREAT

This week beginning on Friday, Fr. Santan Pinto, from India, will lead us in a Lenten Retreat. Fr. Pinto has ministered as a priest in India and for awhile helping Mother Theresa, he also is ministering as a priest in the United States with the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity. Fr. Pinto will be giving 4 talks:

Friday evening 6: pm liturgy and talk

Saturday morning 8:30 am liturgy and talk

Saturday evening 6: pm Liturgy and talk

Sunday afternoon at 4: pm talk followed by 6:pm Liturgy.

Fr. Pinto will also be available to hear confessions after each talk. I have left the "theme" of the retreat in Fr. Pinto's hands so I am not sure just what he will focus on, but whatever he speaks on I know will be helpful for all of us to focus our thoughts on the Lord and journeying on our pilgrimage to the Kingdom of God. Even if you cannot make each talk I encourage you to try to make one of them on next weekend. We can all use a boost in our spiritual life.

Here is a little background on Fr. Santan Pinto.

Fr. Santan Pinto was born in Surendranagar in the Northern state of Gujrat in 1948. He spent his early childhood in Goa, situated on the southwestern coast of India. Goa is the place where the body of St. Francis Xavier lies for public veneration. Fr. Pinto's dad died in 1957 when he was just 9 years old. His mother is still living. He has only one sister who continues to live in Goa. After completing high school he joined the Jesuits and received a Master's degree in Social Work. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1977. After his ordination Fr. Pinto heard this call: "Go to America. I want you to serve there." After leaving the Jesuit Order in 1982 he tried for the next five years to visit America. During a Catholic charismatic conference in 1987, his mother handed him to the care of our Blessed Mother saying: "From today onwards, I offer you to Mary. She will be your mother."

After that day, God provided Fr. Pinto with the means to visit the USA and on May 15th 1987, Fr. Pinto arrived in New York. Later that year he joined the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity. He went through the novitiate in 1988 and since then has been the formation director of the community, forming priest, seminarians, brothers, sisters and lay persons in their respective vocations. Fr. Pinto worked with Mother Theresa and who taught him to recognize Jesus in the poor. Fr. Pinto was elected as the Second Assistant to the "General Priest Council" of the Society and visits the Societies missions throughout the world.
