Thank you to all who helped make our Holy Week masses so beautiful and a special thanks to the choir and Simon Donoghue for the great music, to all the servers who did an excellent job, to all those who helped decorate for Easter, and to those who helped in their ministries: ushers, lectors, Eucharistic ministers. All of you made Holy Week a special week for the parish.

This week Fr. Paul is here from Canada for a brief vacation. It is good to have him back on Island and I hope you all enjoy his time with us.

We have begun the 50 days of celebrating Easter. Now that we have come through the first 8 days, called the Octave of Easter, we continue with the next 7 weeks celebrating the Resurrection of our Lord until the feast of Pentecost. Easter is so marvelous that we need these 50 days to celebrate and reflect on the great mystery of our faith, that of the Resurrection. This week we have the touching story of the resurrected Jesus appearing to the disciples. Imagine that you could come back from the dead to visit your loved ones. What would you say? Perhaps you would tell them one more time that you loved them, or that you were sorry for some grievance. Or perhaps you would tell them what heaven is like or what they need to do to get there. Jesus could have said anything, but what he said was, "Peace." Then he sends the disciples to continue his mission and breathes on them, giving them the Holy Spirit. Finally he says, "If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

Of all the things Jesus could have said, he chose to share with the community of the Church his authority to forgive sins. He chose to share god's mercy to all who come to ask for forgiveness. What a beautiful gift he has given us in his resurrection. God's mercy. If you did not take the time to receive God's mercy and forgiveness before Easter, I hope that you will find the time during these 50 days to celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation and receive God's mercy and forgiveness.
