We celebrate today the feast of the Ascension of Our Lord. A great turning point for the disciples of Jesus. Life consists of one change after another and, as much as we would like to hold one golden moment forever, as the moment when Jesus ascended to heaven, all things pass and the only constant is change. During this time of the year we observe a lot of happy transitions. Students graduate and move on to the next phase of their lives. Many couples choose this time of year to get married. A few weeks ago we baptized new Christians into our community.

Other changes are not so happy. We age. There are diminshments due to illnesses and infirmity. We might lose a job, a home, a spouse, a child. We may suffer with depression or anxiety. We may be the victim of injustice or betrayal. We may ourselves be the betrayer or the victimizer.

When loss happens on a major scale, when war or acts of violence or natural disasters devastate our lives, we are rightly horrified. Yet in each person's individual life there comes an event that threatens to devastate us. We are not free to choose what happens to us. Belief in Jesus Christ does not prevent us from suffering, but our belief gives meaning to our suffering. Viktor Frankl wrote: "The last of the human freedoms is to choose one's attitude." What is your attitude these days as we struggle with the coming hurricane season or the process of fixing up since hurricane Ivan?

Perhaps we can begin developing a little attitude borne of the knowledge that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ; an attitude of confidence and even gratitude amidst life's difficulties.

"...Why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven." Is your attitude one of standing around grumbling or perplexed, or is it one of getting on about the work of the Lord?

This is an appeal to all Adorers and visitors to the Chapel and to anyone who may read this to pitch in and help. All you have to do is check the sheet on the way into the Chapel to see if there are any hours you can do. Put your name and phone number on the sheet, beside the hour (s) you are volunteering for. Make sure you note the date and time on your calendar and then show up promptly. On the day, be sure you sign in (in the sign-in book inside the Chapel). This will alert the person you are replacing that you are there “officially”. *Then, sit back and enjoy your special hour with the Lord, until your replacement arrives.*

The “I Need a Substitute Sheet” is in use year round, but in the summer, with so many regular Adorers and Subs going away, more volunteers are crucial to keep the Chapel open and running smoothly.

At this time, we would also remind all Adorers that it is your responsibility to organize a replacement if you are going to be absent. PLEASE do not just go off on holiday and assume all will be well! First, make every effort to find a replacement using the usual options: the person who shares your hour; family or friends; regular visitors to your hour; the person who sits beside you at Mass every Sunday! Only if these fail, should you put your name on the “I Need a Substitute Sheet”. *And remember, if you use the sheet to find someone, you should be on the look-out in the future for an opportunity to fill in an hour or so for someone else! It's a two-way street.*
