## June 04, 2006—PENTECOST SUNDAY

### M & M's

Today the Christian Church celebrates the Feast of Pentecost - the day the Holy Spirit was poured out on the followers of Christ who had locked themselves away and were trembling for fear that they would meet the same kind of death as the Master. When the Holy Spirit descended on them in the form of wind and fire, they were changed into courageous souls who preached the Good News and eventually were put to death for their faith in Jesus. Pentecost is also a birthday celebration for the Christian Church, as it was on this day that three thousand people first committed themselves to living for Christ through Baptism (Acts 2:41).

Making a commitment to living a Christian life is never easy as it requires that we shed our old habits and take on a new way of living (a radical conversion). I always share with the teenagers that what is expected of us is not easy but is possible. How is it possible? The Holy Spirit, which is given to us by God at different stages in our Christian journey is constantly sustaining and animating us. The catechism teaches that God is love and his first gift to us is love. Romans 5:5 states: "God's love is poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us."

The more we give of ourselves out of love for God and others, the more we are walking by the Spirit and living by the Spirit.

On this day of Pentecost and throughout this week may our prayer be:

*Spirit of Christ, stir me;  
Spirit of Christ, move me;  
Spirit of Christ, fill me;  
Spirit of Christ; seal me,*

*Consecrate in me Your Heart and Will, O Heavenly Father.  
Create in me a fountain of virtues.*

*Seal me as Your own, that Your reflection in me may be a light for all to see.  
Amen.*

It's a two-way street.*
