Thank you to all the parents, grandparents and family members who have helped with the school this year. I also want to thank the teachers and the staff for all their hard work in teaching every day, the cleaners of the school who make it presentable for all the young people every day, and the leadership of our principals. I believe the school year has gone extremely well. There have been problems but I believe that with the encouragement of parents and all of us joining together in bringing out the positive aspects of our school that we will get better and better. We have a great school and we should all be proud of it. The best way we make a school better is not to criticize any little problem but to offer positive suggestions in the areas that are of concern. There will always be problems when you are dealing with over 600 students and almost 100 staff members. But problems are overcome when we look to the good of what we have even in the midst of chaos.

Sometimes Jesus got frustrated with the disciples. They were well-meaning fellows, each with their own gifts, but they were not scholars. They were just plain folks and sometimes they were a little think-headed. Even after months with Jesus, they still didn't get it. They didn't always know who he was or what he was about. In today's Gospel, in the midst of the storm the panicky disciples awaken Jesus, asking, "Don't you care that we are perishing?" After he calms the wind and the waves Jesus asks them why they were terrified. "Do you not yet have faith?" He asks us the same question.

This week we are called to look at difficult situations in our lives and trust that God is in charge and can bring good out of trials. Stepping back and putting things in perspective, in the framework of God's loving care and the true lasting purpose of life is what Jesus calls us to. Trust in providence is challenged when storms strike, not when it's over. The wisdom of "this too shall pass" reminds me of St. Paul's letter to the Romans 8:28: "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God." Fr. Mike
