Fr. Maurice (Mo) Decker is filling in for me while I am on vacation. I know that you will give him a warm welcome. He is a senior priest from the Archdiocese of Detroit but now living and retired in West Palm Beach, Florida. I am happy that he could take the time to fill in for me while I am away. Fr. Enjoys cooking but I am sure would enjoy dinner at your home any night of the week. If you have a chance invite him to your home to experience some home style cooking and that he can see how you live here on the Islands. Fr. Also likes to play golf and if you play you might invite him out to play at the Hyatt course while he is here. I am sure that he would enjoy that. I am in Michigan for the next couple of weeks visiting with family and friends.

Today's second reading is from the Letter to the Ephesians, the Christian community in Ephesus. This letter can be divided into two parts. The first part is about the call we have received as disciples of Christ, that we are chosen and given a mission and a purpose. The second part, which we begin today, is about living the Christian life.

We are called to unity within the community. In today's short passage, Saint Paul uses the word "ONE" seven times. He writes that there is one body (the Christian community); one Spirit (inspiring the community); one hope (our future is with one another); one Lord (to whom we all pledge obedience); one faith (living in accord with what we profess); and one God and Father of all (bound together first as children of the one God, not as citizens of any nation or followers of any earthly leader).

In the Gospel today we hear the familiar story of the feeding of the five thousand. We tend to focus on the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and the fish. Before the miracle there is the divine assumption that all the people should be fed. No one is expendable. Everyone counts.

The Christian life takes on a different cast when we adopt this divine assumption. That the Christian life is about me and God and no one else is seen for what it is—a temptation, albeit one that has been with us since the beginning, In our day, technology enables us to go our own way and disconnect from everyone. Or we can choose to connect with everyone everywhere. Now, as never before in history, we can be one with every person on the earth if we only recognize that ALL are invited to the banquet and that there is enough for everyone when we each take only what we need.

We can add "ONE WORLD" to Saint Paul's list and then heed his plea that we live in a manner worthy of our call, conducting ourselves with humility, gentleness, patience, and bearing with one another in love.

Gracious God, you provide for us abundantly. May we live in your image by sharing our blessings with others.

Vita Consecrata-Apostolic Exhortation of Pope John Paul II

In Pope John Paul's Apostolic Exhortation VITA CONSECRATA or Consecrated Life, section 54 and 55, he states that contacts with the laity, in the case of monastic or contemplative Institutes, take the form of a relationship that is primarily spiritual, while for institutes involved in works of the apostolate, these contacts also translate into forms of pastoral cooperation. The laity is therefore invited to share more intensely in the spirituality and mission of these institutes. Moved by the examples of holiness of the consecrated members, lay men and women will experience at first hand the spirit of the evangelical counsels, and will thus be encouraged to live and bear witness to the spirit of the beatitudes, in order to transform the world according to God's design.

What and who are Missionaries of the Poor-Associates

Fr. Richard HoLung, Superior General of Missionaries of the Poor, a monastic order that is contemplative in action and gives free service to the poor, has invited the laity, to unite themselves with the Lord according to the Spirituality of the Missionaries of the Poor, by becoming associate members.

Purpose

The Primary purpose of MOP associate members is to deepen their lives with the Lord. Under the guidance of MOP, they will be led to mediation on the Scriptures, particularly those passages that pertain to MOP Spirituality.
