The parish office has received word from Fr. Alex, our new associate priest, that he is awaiting his in-transit visa to travel through England to get here. We expect that he will be here in two or three weeks.

On behalf of the entire parish, I would like to express our thanks to Fr. Mo who has been covering for Fr. Mike. He will be here for another week, so please take the time to reach out to him and express your gratitude for his willingness to minister to us over the last two weeks.

This week the church calls us to reflect deeply on the Mystery of the Person of Christ, through the story of the Transfiguration. The Transfiguration of Jesus was a unique and mysterious display of His divinity. It was also a glimpse of the glory which Jesus shared before He came to earth in human form. For Peter, James and John, it was a sneak preview of what they are now enjoying, eternity, that which we are striving for.

Over these last weeks a battle of words has been fought out in a local newspaper about whether or not Jesus is God and the validity of the Trinity. For us, Catholics, today's Gospel reading provides proof that Jesus is the 'Son of God', He is God. As I read these articles, I feel so sorry for these people who are so ignorant of truth. They are trying so hard to use human reasoning to prove to the tee that Jesus was a just a human being and discredit the belief that He is God. They are so wrong, because we cannot and will not be able to reason out Jesus' divinity. It is a MYSTERY! And the world's greatest detective will not be able to solve it.

As much as they do not believe that Jesus is God, their opinion will not change that truth. Jesus is God and He will forever be God!

Two weeks ago Tristan Abbott, Rowena (Winnie) Castillo and myself had the privilege of journeying 'up a high mountain' with twelve teenagers from our parish and 2900 other young people from across the United States. This was in the form of the Steubenville Atlanta High School Conference. For our teens, it was a different experience than they are used to. The theme for the weekend was 'Unchanging' and teenagers were called to reflect on how they can live in God's Unchanging Love. They were challenged by the different speakers to allow the Unchanging God take root in their lives and change them so they can live good, pure, chaste lives.

The highlight of the Conference was Eucharistic Adoration on Saturday night. After this wonderful and emotional experience we had our small group discussion. I remember one of our teenagers sharing that from the experiences she had on that night, Jesus must be real. She pointed out that the teenagers who were crying, praising, singing, and shouting out the name of Jesus, must have had experiences of Him being the 'Son of God' why they were reacting in those different ways.

It was great to hear teenagers being positive and using uplifting words in their conversations with each other. The back and forth cheering for Jesus in the lunch lines or as we were leaving the conference at 11pm each night were great. Imagine groups of young people shouting back and forth: "We love Jesus, YES we do. We love Jesus how about you?"

May we be enthusiastic about our faith in Jesus and His Divinity and boldly share this belief throughout this week.
