I am glad to report that Fr. Alex Crasta has arrived and is here with us to share in ministry with our parish. Fr. Alex came in on Wednesday after 2 days of flying and waiting for airplanes from India. Next week I will have Fr. Alex give a short biography of his life in the bulletin. It is good to have another priest here with us and I know that you will give him a great welcome to our parish. Fr. Alex and I will be sharing in all the masses at both St. Ignatius and Christ the Redeemer and also work at getting over to Cayman Brac at least once if not twice per month.

I thank you for your care and concern with Fr. Mo Decker while I was up in Michigan for my summer break. Fr. Mo said that he truly enjoyed his time here and that we have a great parish. I was very happy that Fr. Mo could be here to fill in for me. Although Bishop Quinn said that he was the last person he could find to fill in, I believe he was probably the best of priests that he could find.

With these last two weeks before school begins and the year once again gets started I hope that most of you also got some break to renew and refresh yourselves before all the activities begin again. The weather has been hot and yet we have been very fortunate not to have any serious weather so far this year. May God bless us with calm winds and seas.

I am looking for a housekeeper and cook for the parish rectory. Our former housekeeper has gone back to the Philippines and will not be returning. The job consists in making lunch (a main meal) for the staff (about 4 or 5 people) Monday through Friday and cleaning the rectory and doing the washing along with doing all the grocery shopping. I would expect the job to be from 9:am to 3: pm Monday through Friday. 30 hours per week. If you are interested please stop by the parish office this week, Monday through Friday, from 8:am to 4:pm and fill out an application form. I hope to make a decision by the end of August.

Today's first reading invites us to partake of the blessings God offers us, rich food and choice wine. Paul warns us not to get drunk on wine, but he doesn't tell us to abstain from it. Jesus is quite blunt: "Amen, Amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." Despite such clear statements from the Lord and his explicit command at the Last Supper for all to eat his body and drink his blood, we still see many Catholics pass by the cup every Sunday. Jesus clearly intended us to share both his body and his blood. Bread is the staff of life. It speaks of substance and sustenance. It invites sharing, and that sharing fosters unity. The word "companion" comes from Latin words that mean a person with whom one shares bread. Wine on the other hand, speaks of joy and festivity and zest for life. It speaks of the spirit.

Also if we look at body and blood: both elements are necessary for life. Blood is especially a symbol of life; that is why the Jews are forbidden to eat meat that has been strangled so that the blood remains in it rather than being given back to God. Bread also recalls manna in the desert and blood recalls the covenants of the Old Testament, sealed with the blood sprinkled on the altar and on the people. So Jesus speaks at the Last Supper of the blood of the new covenant. The symbol of both eating and drinking of the body and blood of Christ is so rich that the Bishops at Vatican II almost demanded that it be restored to all the people at the Eucharistic Celebration. Sharing in both the body and blood of Christ is a precious gift that God has given us. You might want to consider sharing in both elements of the Eucharist if you are not doing so. The bread of life and the cup of blessing are the two most important gifts Jesus has given us.
