Dear Brothers & Sisters,

You had been told quite sometime back about my arrival at St. Ignatius Parish as Assistant Pastor. I am very happy to be in Cayman and especially to be part of this beautiful parish community. Thank you all for your warm welcome and a special thanks to Fr. Mike for making me feel at home.

I come from a strong traditional Catholic family from Mangalore in South India. My parents are deceased. There are six children in my family, four brothers and two sisters. I am the second eldest and the youngest one is a religious sister (nun).

I can trace back my vocation to the priesthood to my high school days when as an altar boy I used to get up early each morning and run to the church - up the hill a mile away, in order to get a chance to serve mass at the altar. This routine continued for at least four years until I joined the seminary to get trained for the priesthood. I still fondly remember the zeal and the enthusiasm I had in attending Mass and other Sacraments.

I joined the religious order called the Pallottines. This religious order was founded by St. Vincent Pallotti, a Roman saint. At the completion of my studies in philosophy and theology along with graduation I was ordained as priest in Goa on the 31st October, 1977. In my last 29 years as priest, most of the time, I have been working in the formation houses where we give training for the seminarians who are aspiring to become priests.

I have also worked as a Pastor of a large parish for three years in the Archdiocese of Hyderabad, India. It was and still is a very dynamic parish with about 5000 Catholics and has a lot of programs and activities for the children, youth and adults.

Besides teaching and retreat ministry, I also enjoy gardening, music and sports. For a healthy distraction, I have some other hobbies such as collecting stamps and numismatics (collecting coins or currency of India & different countries),

It's little more than a week since I arrived here and I have begun to like the place and specially the parish community. I also believe that the best is yet to come!

The readings of today's liturgy put two choices before us: to choose God by believing in Him or to choose other gods of today's world. In the first reading we see Joshua inviting the people to make a choice, a choice as to whom they would serve: the God of their ancestors or the false gods of the land in which they now inhabit. Even the disciples in today's gospel passage are invited to make a choice, to choose Christ or to go away as the rest of the disciples did. We too have made a choice at the time of our Baptism. We chose Christ and rejected Satan and his work. But the question is whether we had been faithful to the choices we made at the time of our Baptism. The reading today invite us to renew our allegiance to Christ and to His teachings. Once again, let us pray for the courage to respond like Peter: "Lord to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life".
