School starts this week and we are looking forward to a great school year. We pray that our teachers and students will all have a safe and happy school year with much learning and understanding going on throughout the school. The teachers and staff have been working this past week getting everything set and there is much excitement with new teachers and new staff bringing in new ideas and new ways of doing things. I believe the students and the parents of our students will find the changes in the school exciting. I was glad to see in the paper this past week that the government is going to increase the help for tuition for Caymanians in A Levels. That could be a big boost for our school. Hopefully we will see an increase in the number of students taking A Levels and staying here at St. Ignatius. Fr. Alex and I are looking forward to this school year and having all the bright, smiling students around again. It has been a quiet two months and it will be good to have everyone back again.

It is good having Fr. Alex here with us in the parish. I am relieved of the pressure of having to do everything and not being able to do many things because of everything else that needed to be done. I am more than happy to have someone who can share in our ministry here in the parish. I hope you got a chance to read his article last week and his excitement about being here in the parish.

Our RCIA program (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is soon to start again this year. This is a program for people who are interested in the Catholic Church, or who would like to be a member of the Catholic Church, or for Catholics who may just want to know more about their faith and background of the Catholic Church. If you know someone who is interested in the Catholic Faith now is the time to encourage them to come to the RCIA classes which meet every Tuesday evening at 6:pm in the Church. There are not too many people who come to us priests who are interested in becoming Catholic unless a parishioner brings them to us. Most often it is you, the parishioner, who can encourage someone to be a part of the Catholic Church. If you know someone who would like to learn about the Catholic Faith encourage them to try the classes on Tuesday evenings. If they do not like them they are not required to keep coming but I bet they would find them interesting enough to keep coming each week. It might be that they would also want you to come with them. That is always welcome at the classes. Any parishioner is welcome to attend the classes and update their own faith in areas that they might not be too sure about. Classes begin this Tuesday night but if you cannot convince them to come this week they would be welcome over the next few weeks.

We are also starting a Bible Study class on Monday evenings at 6:30. The classes will meet this week in the music room in the school. When you go toward Loyola Hall look for the signs that will direct you to the second floor above the Canteen in the school. The class will focus this year on the Acts of the Apostles. Mr. O'Neil Miller is leading the class but probably Fr. Alex and myself will be there most weeks to help out in the discussions with each lesson.

For the next five Sundays we will read from the Letter of James in our Second Reading. James was probably written around 60 AD. It is the first of the "Catholic Epistles," that is, addressed to the whole Church and not to a specific community of Christians such as the Romans or the Corinthians. James has one dominant theme: Christianity if not a religion of theory; faith must be put into practice. He is concerned about some of the Christian communities where the belief that one is saved by faith alone is all they believe. James counters this by saying "Be doers of the word and not merely hearers who deceive themselves." Or as St. Francis of Assisi said, "Preach the gospel always; if necessary, use words."

SCHOLARSHIP APPEAL— A new school year has begun! The St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund has been in existence for the past nine years. The fund was created to allow eligible students to continue receiving a Catholic Education. The annual fee at St. Ignatius are about \$6500 per student. The scholarship fund tries to cover about 15-20% of this for needy families. Last year, thanks to the generosity of parishioners and the sale of Mother's Day/Father's Day cards, we assisted more the 40 children with about CI\$35,000 total. In return for the help the families must volunteer to work at school events during the term. Unfortunately, due to Hurricane Ivan, it has been very difficult to do any fund-raising on the local level over the past two years. At the same time, costs all over the island have risen dramatically, and many families who never previously applied for assistance are now coming forward. Any assistance from the parishioners is always gratefully received. One can never put a tag price on the value of a child's education. Any check should be made payable to
