You will notice that many of the students are wearing new uniforms. We hope to have all the students into these new uniforms by the end of the school year. In the meantime you will see students in last years uniforms and also students in the new uniforms. As usual, the company that supplies the uniforms did not have enough stock to handle the whole school and for some families it is a big cost to buy all new uniforms for their children, so we have given families the whole school year to get what is needed for new uniforms. Hopefully by the end of the school year all our students will have what is needed with new uniforms. Students are told that they are to look neat and tidy in their uniforms where ever they are on the island. If you see any students in our school uniforms any where on the island and they are not wearing them properly, kindly remind them that they should wear their uniforms proudly and be a good example to others even outside of school.

Today we formally welcome Fr. Alex Crasta to our parish with a reception after the 8:30 am mass. Fr. Alex is learning more and more about our parish and all the families in the parish. If you want to get to know Fr. Alex better and have him get to know you and your family, invite him over for dinner some time, as so many of you have done with me, and you will learn more about his time in India and his willingness to come here to the Cayman Islands to minister to our parish.

This week we are reminded of the tragedy of 9/11 and of the difficulties that we have in our world when extremists try to force their message upon the whole world. I am sure that all of us would like to live in peace with everyone and for most governments I am sure that is a goal they too desire. The problem, however, is that our world is not equal in its distribution of wealth, food and education. When people are left with little or no place to call home, have to scrounge every day for the basics of food and have no opportunities to work and make a living, we find them turning to violence and destruction to make their message known. I know this is a somewhat simplistic look at the problem, but we even see this problem in a small way here on our islands. When there is not meaningful work and no money to buy food then we see people turn to violence against each other. How we solve this problem, I am not sure. How can there be enough work for everyone in the world to have a basic existence is a dilemma, but not an impossibility if all governments are willing to work on this. We need to pray and do what we can to make sure that all people in our islands and around the world have the basics of what is needed to exist. Our Islands can be a real example to the world of how society can live and work together for the benefit of all people. But that means that no one can sit back and say let someone else do it. We all have to be involved in making the world a better place.

In the Gospel today Jesus heals a deaf man with the word "Ephphatha." (Be opened) In the rite of baptism we use this same prayer at the end of the rite when the priest or deacon prays that the baptized persons ears and mouth be opened to hear the word of God and speak the word of God. "The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak. May he soon touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father." This needs to be our prayer this week as we contemplate how to bring peace to a troubled and broken world.

SCHOLARSHIP APPEAL— A new school year has begun! The St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund has been in existence for the past nine years. The fund was created to allow eligible students to continue receiving a Catholic Education. The annual fee at St. Ignatius are about \$6500 per student. The scholarship fund tries to cover about 15-20% of this for needy families. Last year, thanks to the generosity of parishioners and the sale of Mother's Day/Father's Day cards, we assisted more the 40 children with about CI\$35,000 total. In return for the help the families must volunteer to work at school events during the term. Unfortunately, due to Hurricane Ivan, it has been very difficult to do any fund-raising on the local level over the past two years. At the same time, costs all over the island have risen dramatically, and many families who never previously applied for assistance are now coming forward. Any assistance from the parishioners is always gratefully received. One can never put a price tag on the value of a child's education. Any cheques should be made payable to **ST. IGNATIUS- SAYM.**
