On October 6, there will be an Annual Worldwide Children's Holy Hour under the auspices of the World Apostolate of Fatima. The intention for this Holy Hour is twofold: *for Peace and the Families of the World.*

These two intentions are closely related. What strain must be placed on family life from being under constant threat of gunfire and missiles. What stress to families who have lost loved ones in this way. Think about the civil war in the Sudan and the resulting starvation. Families are being ravaged by events such as this. What a dreadful effect the recent terrorist attacks in New York and London have had on families and surely on each one of us.

We in Grand Cayman have been wonderfully blessed with peace and prosperity, but families here need prayer as well. Many individual families suffer from illness, the effects of addiction, crime, or simply the everyday tensions of life which lead to family strife and unhappiness. The intention "Peace and the Families of the World" is far-reaching and vital. As members of the world family, it should be an intention that we all bring to prayer.

The prayers of children are extremely powerful. Jesus Himself said "Let the children come to me and do not hinder them; for to such belong the Kingdom of Heaven" (Matthew 19:14). Various Popes have called on children for prayer. In 1994, Pope John Paul II wrote to the world's children, saying, "My Dear Young Friends, it is to your prayers that I entrust the problems of your own families and all the families of the world." More recently, Pope Benedict XVI said, "In my ministry I also count on children's prayers and their active participation in the mission of the church."

WORLD YOUTH DAY 2008

SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA

The St. Ignatius /Christ the Redeemer Catholic Church Community is in the process of planning a pilgrimage for young people from our church and school to the World Youth Day (WYD) 2008 in Sydney, Australia from July 12-21.

The Archdiocese of Detroit has set up a special office to deal with all matters relating to World Youth Day and the parishes within the Archdiocese (including the Cayman Islands).

The Theme for WYD2008 is "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses." Acts 1:8



The estimated cost is \$3,300 US per person. This includes:

- Roundtrip airfare from Detroit-Sydney-Detroit
- World Youth Day registration fees
- Hotel accommodations for 7 days
- Continental Breakfast
- Welcome packet with city maps and pilgrim bag prepared by the welcome committee
- Available WYD representative agent to offer assistance when needed
- Transfer from airport-hotel-airport

The minimum age is 15+ unless an adult is traveling with that child. It is open to young adults up to 40 years.

An initial deposit of \$400 US will be due on November 01, 2006.
