## M & M's

I remember 4 years ago in the months leading up to my marriage to Karyl, I had people from all walks of life giving me the secrets to a good marriage. Many family members and friends were happy for us while others were concerned that we were too young and suggested that we waited for another year or two. Of all the advice that we got, there are two things that I still remember to this day, mainly because they were funny but most of all they had deep meanings. Days before I left Cayman to Jamaica for the wedding, the Font of Life Prayer Group had a send-off blessing for me and Mr. Don deCordova shared the following: "Whenever you build a house, do not build it with any windows or doors because if love should ever leave that house, that will be the end of your marriage." On that same evening, Mrs. Cynthia Pereira, lovingly known as 'Mother P' by all of us, shared with me that throughout her marriage to the late Mr. Joseph Pereira, they rarely had arguments. Everything she said to him, would always receive the response "Yes Dear!" That was the secret to her marriage being a successful one and she begged me to do the same.

Today, Christ is challenging us to get back to the basics of the Sacrament of Marriage and to fully understand what this vocation is all about. Today, more than ever we really need to reflect on marriages, as this sacred institution is under attack from all angles. A divorce is the easiest thing to get these days. Divorces always leave children crying out for help as this is not what is ideal for them as they need to have mom and dad at home. Selfishness is the underlying reason why all marriages lead to divorce because it is all about 'me' and my needs.

The following is a reflection on today's Gospel taken from the Good News Ministry's Daily Reflections:

*In today's Gospel reading, Jesus explains that the law of Moses permitted divorce (Deut. 24:1) only because of the hardness of people's hearts. In the days of Moses, men often treated their wives like possessions, which they could toss away on a whim. When the marriage became difficult or unsatisfying, these men abandoned their wives. Although marriage was supposed to be a permanent commitment that united two people, a bill of divorce allowed the women to remarry. It was an allowance that protected them. It was not intended to be an approval of divorce.*

*The Pharisees who quoted Moses had the same hardness of hearts as the men who mistreated their wives. When Jesus quoted from Genesis, he used it as a teaching tool for those whose hearts are open to love. Permanence in marriage has always been God's will for marriage. Permanence is a divine gift. It's the essence of his relationship with us. If we don't believe in the permanence of love, how can we believe that God is always in love with us, even when we don't deserve it?*

*A marriage in which one spouse stops loving the other is the same as turning away from God. He never forces us to stay "married" to him, but he loves us always. Because of the gift of divine permanence (which is received in the Sacrament of Marriage), the unloved spouse can continue loving the one who quits, even if from afar. This is also true of any God-ordained friendships, priests and their unity with the laity, and parents with their children.*

I leave you with these questions as we reflect on your loving relationships with others, especially in the Sacrament of Marriage, and also our relationship with our loving God.

Have you ever quit a relationship because it was too hard? Did you really stop loving that person? Is the way you handled it like/unlike God? How has God helped you love someone who quit loving you? How did you open yourself to his divine help? Describe how this reveals to others what God's love is really like.

## WORLD YOUTH DAY 2008

### SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA

The St. Ignatius /Christ the Redeemer Catholic Church Community is in the process of planning a pilgrimage for young people from our church and school to the World Youth Day ( WYD ) 2008 in Sydney, Australia from July 12-21.

The Archdiocese of Detroit has set up a special office to deal with all matters relating to World Youth Day and the parishes within the Archdiocese ( including the Cayman Islands ).



The Theme for WYD2008 is "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses." Acts 1:8

The estimated cost is \$3,300 US per person. This includes:

- Roundtrip airfare from Detroit-Sydney-Detroit
- World Youth Day registration fees
- Hotel accommodations for 7 days
- Continental Breakfast
- Welcome packet with city maps and pilgrim bag prepared by the welcome committee
- Available WYD representative agent to offer assistance when needed
- Transfer from airport-hotel-airport

*The minimum age is 15+ unless an adult is traveling with that child. It is open to young adults up to 40 years.*

An initial deposit of \$400 US will be due on November 01, 2006.
