## M & M's

This week we will celebrate two great feasts of the Church: ALL SAINTS DAY and ALL SOULS DAY. In the Antilles Conference of Bishops these are not declared HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION but they still are Holy Days. A Holy Day is one in which we make a special effort to come to church to share in these feasts by praying that God will give us the courage of the Saints and that we pray for all who have died in our parish and families. I encourage you to join us on Wednesday morning at 7:am to celebrate All Saints, and also on Thursday morning at 7:am to share in remembering all those who have died in our parish this last year and throughout the year. The Book of the Dead will be in the church again and you can put the names of family and friends that have died over this last year in the book. If you have put in names over the last 5 years those names are there at the beginning of the book. Please only add names of those who have died since last November 2005.

This week we have available tickets for our Parish and School Fund Raiser. Books of tickets are available at the parish office and the school office. I encourage all families to try to sell at least one book of tickets. There are just 10 tickets in a book and each ticket sells for \$25 CI. However, for the last ticket, the 10th ticket, you can sell it and keep the \$25 CI, or you can just put your name on the ticket for free. When you turn in the book of stubs you only need turn in the money for 9 tickets, \$225 CI. Plus if you are the seller of the winning top prize ticket you will win \$2,500 CI. Not bad just before Christmas. The drawing will take place on Cayman 27 TV on the 22nd of December. Just in time to pay for the Christmas gifts for one happy family. Help the parish and the school by stopping by to pick up a book of tickets this week. The parish office is open from 8:am to 4:pm.

Today I presented our Financial Report for the year 1 July 2005 to 30 June 2006. We have finished all the rebuilding we need from Hurricane Ivan and have put aside from pledges and contributions for the new church in Cayman Brac almost \$300,000. But our weekly collections have been down over the summer and with a second priest here in the parish and the costs of living going up since Hurricane Ivan we need to ask for an increase in your weekly contribution to the parish. I ask each of you to take seriously the gift of Stewardship. Time, Talent, and Treasure. These sum up the gifts we have been given by God, and which we—as stewards—are to “manage” for God’s purposes. These categories can seem somewhat artificial. For example, it’s not always easy to distinguish between giving our time and giving our talent. Maybe more contemporary terms would help. For some, it might be easier simply to speak of “skills” and “money”.

**SKILLS:** We may or may not have highly specialized skills, but we all have skills. If we listed them, we might surprise ourselves. Many of the things on the list would seem simple and normal. But the truth is, we all have many skills which we use just to get through a day.

**MONEY:** Whereas “treasure” may evoke thoughts of riches, “money” is something that is just plain part of life. We speak of our wages as “earning a living.”

Stewardship poses the question: How do I make use of my skills and my money? In other words, do I handle these as gifts belonging to God, which I am meant to manage on God’s behalf and for God’s purposes? Or do I consider my skills and my money as belonging to me—possessions which I occasionally bestow on others?”

That is the question, and how we answer the question makes all the difference in the world. And the difference, by the way, deals not so much with the effects upon others, but with the effects upon me. Not the need of others to receive. But my need to give.
