M & M's

I was very pleased last week in our collection after I gave the financial state of our parish for last year. It is very grateful that so many of you would consider tithing. Being good stewards of what God has given us brings blessing beyond what we can imagine. Our parish should be able to be financially stable with the number of parishioners that we have. I encourage each of you to be good stewards for the parish and consider giving 5% of your income to the parish, to the works of God, as the first thing you do with your pay.

Our Parish and School Fund Raiser has begun. I encourage each family to sell at least one book of tickets. A visitor to our parish has been very generous for the fund raiser and has given a donation that would buy 328 tickets for parishioners. So we decided that the best way to do that was to buy a ticket for the first 328 people that sell a book of tickets. If you sell 2 books we will buy two tickets for you and so on until we reach 328 tickets. This gives each of you who sell a book to add your own name on the 10th ticket and then you can get a second ticket free if you return the book and the money for 9 tickets while the offer is good. As I mentioned last week, if we keep our collections up to \$10,000 each week then we can give all the monies we make in this Fund Raiser for the Church in Cayman Brac.

"Therefore you shall love the Lord God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength." "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." The Great Commandments. We've heard this. It is kind of vague, isn't it? Or maybe, like, impossible? Mother Theresa was often justifiably considered in her time as a living saint with seemingly near perfect love of God and of neighbor. Unfortunately, this may have led to MTCS—the Mother Theresa Comparison Syndrome: "I'm not like Mother Theresa, so there is no way I can..." MTCS seems to explain and even justify being lukewarm Catholics.

Are you affected with MTCS? If somehow you could know the percentage of your heart, soul, mind, and strength with which you love God, would you want to know? If you measured 50 percent, would you be satisfied, maybe even relieved? At what point would you be dissatisfied?

The Great Commandments were for all, not the spiritual top 3 percent; all are called to sanctity. There is an All Or Nothing Trap: Our falling short of perfection does not mean it is futile to keep trying; we do not in other areas of our lives such as Romance. Ordinary things done well means that we consistently try doing the next right thing. This goes a long way toward loving God and neighbor with our whole heart. Often we need to pray for discernment: "Show me what to do." When we have failed to do the right thing, we need not give up because there is always a next time when we can do the right thing.

You have a gift. You have a skill. Find your gift. Find your skill. And use it. You can make life better in this world just by letting your light shine and by doing your part.
