NEW YEARS'S RESOLUTIONS

As we begin a new calendar year it is good to see how our resolutions are in putting Christ more into our daily lives. Statisticians tells us that the average life span is now around 75 years. A few years ago someone went through the trouble to research what people do with their time, and came up with these results: If we live to be 75, most of us will have spent 3 solid years, 24 hours a day, acquiring an education—grade school, high school, college.

We will have spent 7 years eating, 24 hours a day—some more, some less, obviously.

16 years, day and night working. 5 years riding in cars or airplanes.

5 years talking with each other—some more, some less.

24 years sleeping. 3 years reading books, magazines and newspapers.

12 years watching amusing ourselves: TV, going to movies, and playing sports, fishing,

etc.

That totals 75 years. If you spent every Sunday of your life for 75 years going to church you would have a total of 5 1/2 months praising God. If you did Religious Education and never missed a class the time spent for God would then be 11 months. If you spent one hour a week in the adoration chapel for 75 years that would equal 4 1/2 months, 24 hours a day. If you add the hour for Mass on Sunday and an hour in the adoration chapel each week you still do not get one year of worshipping God 24 hours a day. Maybe we need to spend more time with God.
