## M & M's

I received this note from our Apostolic Delegate, Archbishop Thomas Gulikson, on our collection for Peter's Pence last year.

Dear Father Molnar,

At the Holy Father's direction, I am writing to acknowledge the sum of US \$5,426 which you kindly forwarded to the Apostolic Delegation as the Peter's Pence offering of the Cayman Islands for the year 2006.

His holiness is most appreciative of the charitable assistance which the faithful have given to him in his service to the Church throughout the world. He sees in this gift a sign of ecclesial communion, motivated by faith in Jesus Christ and devotion to the See of Peter.

Assuring the clergy, religious and laity of the Cayman Islands of a remembrance in his prayers, the Holy Father cordially imparts his Apostolic Blessing as a pledge of joy and peace in the Lord.

With every best wish, I remain Yours sincerely in Christ.

Each of the three scripture selections for today shares a similar setting. In each instance, the people of God have gathered together in order to hear the Word of God proclaimed in their midst. In each instance, that Word communicates both blessing and challenge. In each instance, a response on the part of those present and listening is expected.

From Jesus in the synagogue at Nazareth, from Paul's converts gathered at a house church in Corinth, from Ezra and all who came together at the Water Gate, we turn to another setting and another assembly, our own—the community of St. Ignatius/Christ the Redeemer Church, gathered this day 20th and 21st of January 2007, around the Word of God. Here we stand, men, women and children old enough to understand. Here, we, too, are blessed and challenged by God's Word.

Shall we, like Ezra and the Israelites, find in the Word of God a cause that will rouse our faith and a plan that will inspire in us good deeds? Good lives? Shall we too rejoice in celebrating the gift of the Word that brings us life?

Shall we, like Paul's correspondents, hear the Word and be reminded that we are uniquely blessed individuals who, by grace, are capable of being bound inextricably to one another as one body? Shall we be, in turn, mutual blessings for one another? Shall we honor and value our differences as God-given or shall we affirm the suspicions of the disbelieving, that true community, caring and sharing is an unrealistic and unattainable ideal?

This past week 3 priests from Detroit visited us. Msgr. Mike LeFevre, Fr. Mike Hrydziszko and Fr. Steve Koehler. Also visiting for a few weeks are Bishop Murray and Msgr. Bob Lundsford from the Diocese of Kalamazoo, Michigan. And coming in this week will be two more priests from the Archdiocese of Detroit. They are young, only a few years ordained, and I have not met them before so it will be good to have them here and be able to meet a couple of the younger priests of the Archdiocese. Also Bishop Quinn will be coming in on Thursday to share in the Sacrament of Confirmation this coming Sunday at the 8:30 am Mass. There are 34 young people being Confirmed next Sunday at the 8:30 morning mass. This should make for a very large crowd and you might want to plan to attend a different mass if you do not have a connection with anyone being confirmed.

It is always good to have priests and Bishops come down to share in a little warm weather during this winter season in Michigan. I hope that you enjoy our masses with these different priests and bishops.
