We are happy to have Bishop John Quinn, Auxiliary of the Archdiocese of Detroit, with us this weekend to celebrate Confirmation.

Today's readings provide a natural basis for a focus on life. God tells Jeremiah that God knew him even before he was formed in the womb. God promises to strengthen the prophet to speak God's word against all opposition. The Gospel also speaks of opposition to prophecy as Jesus experienced it when he preached God's word. The second reading, Paul's great poetic treatise on love, reminds us that our efforts to protect life must always be guided by love if we are to have any hope of success.

A focus on life is more than a focus on abortion. Our bishops around the world have repeatedly reminded us that respect for life covers a multitude of issues, from abortion to euthanasia, from war to capital punishment, from care for the poor to help for those with disabilities. If we claim to be pro-life, we must manifest a commitment to life at all its stages and challenge our society about all the ways that it devalues human beings.

St. Paul today reminds us that "love is patient, love is kind..." In order for us to have a respect for all life we need to be reminded of the love that God asks us to have in our lives in order that we might protect and value all life.
