## **M & M's**

**It was very good to have Bishop Quinn with us last week celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. We thank him and always enjoy his time with us here in the Cayman Islands.**

**The National Assessment of Living Conditions next phases will start soon. You may be chosen for an interview and asked to complete a questionnaire, or you may be asked to record your spending or join a group discussion. This information will ultimately assist in improving the quality of life for everyone. If asked I ask that you participate and urge that you assist as wholeheartedly as you can.**

**This past week I was in Cuba for the first time in my life. It was a very enjoyable trip and very enlightening as to their society. I will say more about that next week.**

**Next week is World Marriage Sunday and we are having some special events planned for the masses. At each mass we will ask those who have been married in the Church to stand and make a renewal of your marriage vows if you so choose. We will also be con-validating some marriages of couples where at least one of the spouses are Catholic and who married civilly but not in the Catholic Church. We validate their civil marriage in the eyes of the church and ask God's blessing upon them as they continue their married life.**

**Marriage is a very beautiful Sacrament of the Church. It is the only Sacrament that a priest or a bishop has no power to make happen. The bride and groom are the ones who, through their consent, make a covenant with God to be faithful, love each other, be open to having children, and want to care for each other until their spouse dies. It is in giving their consent to each other that the Sacrament takes place. The priest and the best man and maid or matron of honor are the witnesses of this taking place. All the other Sacraments it is the priest or the bishop who confer the sacrament upon the individual. But in marriage it is the bride and groom who confer this Sacrament upon each other.**

**We pray that all marriages in our community will continue to grow in God's love and their love for each other.**

**Today's first reading presents us with one of the sources of our liturgy. The "Holy, Holy" that is part of every Eucharistic Prayer begins with the words of the angels during the vision Isaiah saw when he was called by God to be a prophet. The "Holy, Holy" is one of the oldest pieces of our liturgical tradition. These same words link us to the universal call to holiness that was stressed by the Second Vatican Council. Like the call of the disciples in the Gospel, we too are called to "Come, follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." To bring others to the Church we too have to be a holy people. A people who are willing to share and express their holiness in daily life. May we know the goodness of being a holy people of God.**
