### M & M's

Ash Wednesday is this coming Wednesday. We will have mass at 8:30 am here at St. Ignatius and 10:45 in West Bay where the distribution of ashes will take place during the liturgy. If you cannot make those time you will be able to administer ashes yourself on your forehead throughout the day at St. Ignatius Church. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

**ABSTINENCE:** is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain are encouraged to share in some other form of fasting.

**FAST AND ABSTINENCE:** In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-60. On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together these two meals should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, which are not food supplements, are allowed. If a person is not able to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

Also During this Lenten Season we will have stations of the cross every Friday evening at 5:15 pm followed by 6:pm mass at St. Ignatius.

Also on the Fridays of Lent there will be a Fish Fry in our canteen from 5:pm to 8:pm. The proceeds for this will go to our World Youth Day Fund to help some of our Young People in the parish to go to World Youth Day in Australia in July of 2008.

We will have evenings of reflection/mission on March 7, 8 & 9 with Msgr. John Zenz from Detroit. Msgr. Zenz is a highly respected speaker in the Archdiocese of Detroit and gives a series called "Theology Unplugged" throughout the Diocese. Msgr. Zenz is Moderator of the Curia for the Archdiocese which means he moderates all the staff for the Archdiocese of Detroit. I believe that you will enjoy listening to the talks of Msgr. Zenz who will be speaking about family values in our present culture and how to be a spiritual family in relations to Scripture and being a nurturing and reconciling family. Msgr. Zenz is a very engaging priest and brings much life and discussion with his talks.

Also we will have a mini-novena, 5 days of prayer, singing, scripture reflection and quiet time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament from Monday the 19th of March to Friday the 23rd of March at 7:pm each evening. These will be similar to the Novena we have at the beginning of Advent but I will base them on the cross and the resurrection.

A few more days and Ash Wednesday will be here. But where will you be? What chance has Lent got in modern lives, busy lives, lives with calendars set by our places of work, by sports, by our organizations and our government, by paychecks, by schools whose various winter/spring breaks come regardless of what we are doing or not doing. Lent is really unknown to the larger society, except that we have Ash Wednesday here on the Islands as a holiday and many people celebrate it with a party. But Lent is a vital part of our church here on the Islands, and should sound like good news to us. But I know to some it sounds terrifying because they do not want to disrupt their normal schedule. There are 3 disciplines for Lent. **PRAYER, FASTING and ALMSGIVING.** I hope that many of you will once again make a serious commitment to be at morning mass at 7:am to hear and reflect of the beautiful Scripture readings of Lent. That you might make some room for an hour of prayer a week in our Eucharistic Chapel. That you fast from hurting others by our words and actions (Today's Gospel). That we can put God first in what we return to Him through the Church and the work of the Church.

## ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent.. It occurs forty six days before Easter, but Lent is nevertheless considered forty days long, because the Sundays in this period are not counted as days of penance. Lent can fall on different dates from year to year, it can occur as early as February 4 or as late as March 10. At the Masses and Services on Ash Wednesday, the priest or the minister marks the forehead of each participant with black ashes in the shape of a cross as he says the following words: *"Remember man, that you are dust and unto dust you shall return (Gen. 3:19)*
