Last weekend at the masses I said, I announced that I have chosen to return to Detroit and take a new assignment there in the Archdiocese. When I was first assigned to the Catholic Church in the Cayman Islands it was for 5 years with the anticipation that I would return to Detroit and be assigned another parish. During my 5th year here, we were hit by Hurricane Ivan and the Cardinal asked me to stay a few more years until all was settled. I was very happy with that because I did not want to just get up and leave when so much had to be done and we needed to rebuild not only the physical aspects of the parish, but rebuild our lives of faith and love for each other during that time of devastation. I believe that we have accomplished a good portion of both of those aspects in our parish. The parish has rebuilt physically all that is needed to hopefully last through any hurricane we experience here again and our parish family has grown and worked together to bring the peace and calm needed to sustain us during difficult times on our Islands. There are some things that still need to be done such as building a church on Cayman Brac, which we are in the process of doing. We still need to work on bringing the two communities of St. Ignatius and Christ the Redeemer together as one community. We still need to look at how we can respond to the needs of people in the Eastern Districts of the Island, and we need to look at how our school helps the parish fulfill its role of education in a Catholic Community. So that leaves some work for the next pastor who will come here.

I truly have enjoyed the 7 years I have been here and how you have brought me into your homes and your families. Although this is a transient community of people coming and going for the most part, the urges to return "home" become stronger the longer one stays here, even for those who are born on the Islands the urge to return to Cayman, to return "home", is a strong urge. For the most part I have felt at "home" here in the Cayman Islands but I believe the Holy Spirit is calling me to something new; that I have done what was needed to be done, and it is time for another shepherd to lead you on toward the kingdom of God. I will not be leaving until the end of June so we have time to say thanks to each other and share in the love that God has blessed us with. There is a beautiful spirit here in the Catholic Church in the Cayman Islands that is beginning to make a deep impression in all aspects of the Islands. May this Spirit continue to guide us and bring us the peace and security of God's love throughout our lives.

I want to thank all of you who took time to join in the 5 evenings of reflection this past week. We had about 100 people attend the hour of prayer each night. As we reflected on the readings of Holy Week, I hope that we may enter more prepared to share in the joy of that week, were we celebrate the days of our salvation. In reflecting on the dinner with Martha, Mary and Lazarus where Mary anointed the feet of Jesus, the betrayal of Jesus by Judas, the denial of Peter, the washing of the feet of the Apostles and sharing in the Last Supper, and in reflecting on the events of Good Friday, I hope that a great appreciation of those days will help us rejoice in the joy of Easter.

THE SCRUTINIES

This Sunday at the 8:30am Mass we will celebrate the Third and Final Scrutiny for those in our catechumenal process who are preparing for initiation at the Easter Vigil.

The Scrutinies are also called "Major Exorcisms." As such, they are among the most ancient prayers in the Christian Liturgical tradition. As early as the second century, Christian communities would help those who had been chosen for Baptism to prepare for their initiation by laying on hands and by prayers for protection and deliverance from evil.

Today we continue to celebrate these powerful rituals, convinced that those about to enter into a covenant with God in Christ stand in need of prayers for deliverance and protection. We also understand today that our prayers for protection from evil are not limited to those formally engaged in the catechumenal process. Just as our entire community is called to journey with the catechumens throughout this Lenten season, we recognize the need we all share for freedom from evil and its effects.

Your prayers and your support are important for our sisters and brother who have been journeying for so many months towards the Sacraments of Initiation. Please continue to hold in your Lenten prayers, the elect who count on you for support in making their faith journey.
