Wishing you all a very Blessed and Joyful Easter

Rejoice with all creation! Like a lily's trumpet, let us sing out the joy of Easter Resurrection. Alleluia!

On this Easter Sunday I pray that you find hope in Christ's victory over death—for all who are one with Christ will also rise on the Great Easter morning freed from the prisons of the decaying, dusty tombs. They will arise to a fullness of living and loving, beyond all time and space, in a life one with God. Christ is risen, Alleluia! Soon, all our holy dead and we ourselves will follow! Alleluia! Alleluia! What a great feast Easter is. To know that the Lord Jesus has risen from the dead and will call all of us to share in His resurrection. It is also with great joy that Cardinal Maida has named Father Paul Ballien as the new pastor for the Catholic Church in the Cayman Islands. Fr. Paul Ballien visited the island a few years ago and was greatly impressed by the Catholic Church here and hoped that he could some day be assigned here. I do not know a lot of the background of Fr. Paul but I am sure that we will get more information about him in the next few months. Fr. Paul Ballien is scheduled to take over on July 1, 2007. Cardinal Maida has granted me a 6 month sabbatical in which I will be going to Rome to study. That is the plan for right now. If a priest dies or becomes incapacitated before that I may have to change those plans and fill in at a parish in Detroit. But for now this is the plan.
