I received this e-mail from Cardinal Maida this week and he has asked that it be communicated with all of you here in the parish.

Dear Father Molnar:

I am writing you via e-mail and ask that you share this letter with the community at St. Ignatius Parish, Grand Cayman.

For some months now, you have indicated to me a desire to return to the Archdiocese; after seven years on Grand Cayman, quite naturally and reasonably, you are looking for the opportunity to be closer to family, friends, and fellow priests. I also know you communicated that desire to Bishop Quinn and Monsignor Zenz during their recent visits. I fully understand and agree with the wisdom of returning home, inasmuch as the circumstances of life in the Cayman Islands is literally quite isolating. I have always believed it is healthy for priests to have a change in assignment and I especially think it appropriate in this circumstance.

In deference to your request for a change, I am pleased to announce that we have a new pastor to replace you at St. Ignatius—Father Paul Ballien. Ordained in 1999, Father Ballien has already had extensive experience. He served in two parishes as an associate; he was an administrator at another parish, and currently serves as pastor of St. Basil the Great in Eastpointe, Michigan. I know your community will appreciate his gifts and talents. He visited St. Ignatius a few years back and is familiar with the circumstances of the parish and the mission and the school.

I am also pleased to grant you, Father Molnar, the well deserved sabbatical opportunity you have requested. I know you will be working with Monsignor Zenz and his staff in trying to finalize those details.

As the parish goes through a time of transition this summer, please convey to all your parishioners my special prayerful remembrance. I trust that Father Alex Crasta, SAC, will provide continuity in this time of transition.
