BUILDING THE CHURCH IN CAYMAN BRAC

In the bulletin today we have a drawing of the church we would like to build in Cayman Brac. We have been working on the plans for over a year now and hope that this one will be accepted by the Archdiocese of Detroit. However, we still have a ways to go in raising the money needed to build the church. We need to have about \$400,000CI in order to build this church in case or in pledges.

This is what we have so far:

94 families from the parish have given:	\$ 90,882.00 CI
Donations from anonymous givers:	\$171,806.00 CI
Donations from the Priests in Detroit:	\$ 11,550.00 CI
Total of Donations so far 26/04/07:	\$274,238.00 CI

So you see we need about \$125,750 CI more in donations or written pledges to get to \$400,000 CI in order to present to Detroit our plans and their acceptance. If you would like to make a pledge or give a donation for the Building of the Church in Cayman Brac you may do so by using the form at the bottom of this article and putting it in an envelope and dropping it in the collection or bringing it to the parish office. I was hoping that we would have enough money to build the church before I left so that the new pastor, Fr. Paul Ballian, would be able to present the plans and begin building the church before the end of this year. If you could help in the building of the church in Cayman Brac I am sure the blessings of the Lord will be with you. If we have 125 more families give or pledge \$1,000 CI we would be able to take the plans to Detroit to get their approval and begin building the church.

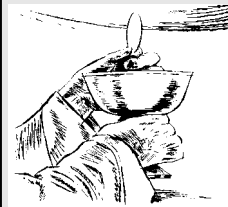
