During the month of June we have a large number of events planned. Some for me as I will be leaving the parish on the 26th of June to head back to the Archdiocese of Detroit and others that celebrate our faith and time for socializing as a community. As I share in this last month here in the parish I am both excited and sad in leaving. Excited at the new opportunities that await me in the Archdiocese, and a chance to go to Rome, Italy for 3 months and even be able to meet Pope Benedict the XVI. Sad that I am leaving as your pastor after having shared in your lives and growing in our faith. It truly has been an exciting 7 years here in the parish of St. Ignatius, Christ the Redeemer and Cayman Brac. I have grown in faith and love during my time here as your pastor and hope that we can all continue in our pilgrimage to the Kingdom of Heaven.

This weekend I am in Cayman Brac for my last time. I will celebrate the liturgy at 11:am there in Cayman Brac and we will have a reception following the mass. I have really enjoyed the times I have been able to go over there to have mass even if the congregation was small. Cayman Brac is a special place of relaxing and quieting ones self down for a little while. It is like having the whole Island for a retreat. I will miss going over there and relaxing and being quiet with the Lord and all those on the Island.

On the 8th of June there is a special dinner being put on to help raise money for our Youth who will be going to World Youth Day and representing all of us in Australia. They are having an Italian Night, Dinner Delight. The meal is spaghetti, lasagna, garlic bread, salad, desert and drinks. It will be served from 5:pm to 8:30pm in the school canteen. The cost is just \$10 for adults and \$8 for those 12 and under. You can come for dinner and meet other parishioners and enjoy the company, or take it home if you wish as a take out. ### This Week...

There is a special relationship between God our Creator, Jesus our Redeemer, and their Holy and Divine Spirit. One of the greatest mysteries of our faith is the Trinity-the one God that is, at the same time, three distinct persons-all affecting our life, and all entities with whom we can relate. We are part of and share in the delight of God the Creator's creation and the grace that Jesus won for us. We can also share in the truth that the Spirit brings to us.

### For Your Reflection

Saint Patrick is famous for making the shamrock a handy tool to illustrate the Blessed Trinity: one plant, three leaves that are all connected and united-symbolizing the one God, three persons that are all connected and united.

Sometimes close relationships are also compared to the Trinity: the person you love, the person who loves you, and God. If God is a part of your relationship, it's hard to think of the two of you without the power, joy, and courage that God brings. Do you have any relationships like that? Where are they like?

A family, a team, or a close group of friends can also form a community of love that is similar to the Trinity-several persons that are connected and united in a very special way. Do you belong to any such group? If so, what makes it special?

The Holy Spirit brings the truth of God. Sometimes in our life we are running away from a truth, or trying to ignore or avoid it. What basic truth in your life do you think God wants you to be more aware of?

Sometimes in our life, when we have done something wrong or when we are about to do something wrong, the Spirit of God speaks to us through our conscience. Have you ever thought about doing something, until that voice inside you called you to do something else? What happened?

The main message of every Gospel is to know the way of the Spirit and to follow the way of the Spirit. How easy is it to live your life that way? How is living your life that way similar to preaching the Gospel?
