## **M & M's**

Next Sunday is the last time I will be celebrating the Weekend Liturgies here at our parish. It is with sadness and excitement that I leave as your pastor for these last 7 years. Sad that I come to the end of an assignment that has brought me much love and joy in the many families that have shared their lives with me. Excitement that I am going on to another challenge given to me by the Lord. Not sure exactly where He is leading me but open to His calling.

I remember when I first heard about the Cayman Islands. I was at a meeting of the Presbyterial Council, where the Cardinal meets with priests elected to represent their area of the Archdiocese. The Cardinal stated that Rome had asked him if he would accept responsibility of the Catholic Church in the Cayman Islands. And then he asked us priests for our response, if this was a good idea or not. Almost all the priests thought it was a great thing for the Archdiocese to do but for most their first question, like mine, was where are the Cayman Islands? We had a couple of priests that had been here to visit and they explained where they were and what a great thing this would be. So the Cardinal accepted the word of his council and said yes to accepting that responsibility. I joked with the Cardinal that that would be a great assignment not thinking that I even had a chance to go there. When I got the call from the Cardinal's secretary asking me if I would like to go to the Cayman Islands as pastor I was humbled and excited that he would think this would be good for me. I could not wait to come "down to the Islands" and share the Word of God with a people that I knew nothing about. We just never know where God takes us.

Over the last 7 years I have been able to learn about the culture of the Cayman Islands and have found it exciting and challenging. It is not the USA nor is it England but a real combination of the best of both those worlds. It is also unique in its mixture of people from all over the world in a small space living and working and enjoying the beauty of the Islands together. It is not a perfect place, but it really is a beautiful place.

I thank you for accepting me as your pastor. Each priest who comes here as your pastor adds something to the parish that others have not. I hope that I have added to your love of God, your love of Scripture and your love of the Eucharist. Living the Eucharist each and every day of our lives is not an easy thing. It is tough to be a Christian in this world and even on these Islands. We do have to make the commitment to keep Christ in our lives, our speech, our actions each moment of the day. Without that commitment we forget who we are and what we should be doing. You have helped me live this commitment in my daily life by your great response to Eucharist. The number who come to daily mass at 7:am is truly impressive. The number who come to the Novenas is tremendous. The number who come for daily prayer in the adoration chapel is exemplary.

I know that you will reach out in love to Fr. Paul Ballien as your new pastor as so many of you did for me and for Fr. Alex when he came here. Your generosity in sharing the goodness of your life is what makes this community one that does stand out on the Islands. May God bless all of you with His grace and peace and give you the courage to be strong in your faith and example of Christian goodness to all.
