Included with your parish bulletin this week is a letter requesting your support for Peter's Pence. This is a collection that is taken up around the world for our Holy Father Pope Benedict XVI. Our Holy Father sends the monies to areas of the world that need special attention. Please take time to read the letter and use the envelope in next week's collection.

Today we celebrate in the Liturgy the feast of the Nativity of John the Baptist. It is not often that the Church celebrates a feast of a saint on Sundays, but in this case it is important for us to celebrate the life of this great saint. The patterns of God's plans are revealed in the birth of John the Baptist. Jesus needed John to announce his coming. John needed his father's restored voice to name and authenticate him. Mary needed to visit Elizabeth so the unborn John could point to Jesus. Zechariah needed his disbelief in order to be made silent. Elizabeth and Zechariah needed to be kept barren until old age. Zechariah needed to be of the family of David. David needed to become king to establish the lineage of Jesus, the promised Messiah.

The patient hand of God plants the seeds centuries before they bear fruit. In each of our lives there is a pattern of God's hand at work. Take some time today to look at your own family history and see the many ways God worked to get you here.

I look at the process that I came here to the Islands and see God's hand working. The Jesuits from Kingston, Jamaica were called by God to come to these Islands to set up a Catholic Community. When they no longer had enough priests to send the Kingston Archdiocese became responsible and when Kingston could no longer take that responsibility it was given to Detroit. Had I not mentioned to the Cardinal that I would enjoy serving the Church in the Cayman Islands someone else probably would have been sent. But God worked his way for me to get me here and I thank Him for all the planning he did in making that happen. God works throughout our lives and often we do not see His plan while we are living our day to day activities. But if we take time to think about it, we all are fulfilling a plan that God has for us.

That plan of God always gives me cause to rejoice because I know that God is not going to place me in a "bad" place. He is always looking out for my good and I know he has the best in store for me. God loves us all so very much and has given us good hearts to accept his way and plan. I pray and will continue to pray as I leave this community for you to know that your heart is good and God gives you all you need to fulfill His plan and be able to rejoice in what he has called you to do.

My final prayer for all of you is the prayer of St. Ignatius:
Teach us, Lord, to serve you as you deserve; to give and not count the cost; to fight and not heed the wounds; to toil and not seek rest; to labour and not ask for any record save that of knowing that we do your will.
