From the Pulpit

Some of you might remember a priest by the name of Fr. Ray Bucon. He spent some time this past Spring on Cayman Brac ministering to the people there. He is an Archdiocese of Detroit priest, and he also happens to be an Army chaplain. I just learned that Fr. Ray is going to be redeployed for a third time back in Iraq at the end of September. I myself have a brother-in-law who just retired from the Marines a month ago. The sacrifices these men make as they go off to war is nothing short of heroic, not to mention the fact that it is also difficult on the families as well. Therefore, I ask that you please pray for Fr. Ray and the protection of his unit, and that they will all come home safely.

Also, as I'm sure most of you are aware from last week's bulletin, Fr. Mike has been recently diagnosed with cancer and is now undergoing treatment. Because of this, some people suggested that maybe we should do a Mass for him, which I thought would be a good idea. As a result, it seems to me that a good time to have a Mass for Fr. Mike would be on the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, which happens to be on Saturday, the 15th of September. Since we don't typically do Saturday morning Masses, except for the first Saturday of the month, I will make an exception this week and add on a Saturday morning Mass at 8:30 that day in honor of our Lady, with the intention of that Mass being for Fr. Mike. All are welcome to attend.

Last of all, don't forget that in two weeks, Fr. Holung and friends will be here on Cayman to perform their opera, 'Isaiah.' I encourage you to attend if you can. If I'm not mistaken, I also believe that they will be singing at one of our Masses on Sunday as well. Please be sure to welcome them when they come.

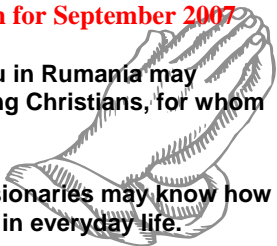
