Just as when the Holy Spirit came down upon the apostles and inspired them to go out to give witness about Jesus Christ and spread the good news, our church community will pray that this outpouring of the Holy Spirit through the sacrament of Confirmation will inspire in you a desire to give witness to the Lord through words and action so that everyone may know the love and life that Jesus Christ has to offer all of us.

As many of you probably already know, Fr. Donald Calloway is coming here this week as well. Fr. Donald Calloway has a fascinating and dramatic story as to how he came to the Catholic Church and became a priest. He is certainly a dynamic speaker and you won't want to miss his talk.
