### From the Pulpit

I wanted to remind you once more that we have a number of activities coming up this week for your spiritual benefit. On Tuesday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, we will have a Communal Reconciliation Service. There will be a number of priests from the Archdiocese of Detroit that will be on hand besides myself and Fr. Alex to hear confessions. Because we have a good number of priests, this would obviously be a good time to make your confession this Lent. Remember, Easter is just three weeks away.

Also, on Wednesday and Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm, we have a mini retreat sponsored by the Christian Service Commission featuring videotaped talks by Fr. Corapi. The mini retreat will take place in the church building.

On Saturday, March 8<sup>th</sup> through the 12<sup>th</sup>, we will have a mini novena starting at 7:00 pm. The novena will only be five days instead of nine. The theme of the novena will be: "Christ, the suffering servant." The format of the novena will be similar to what we did for the novena in December.

Also, don't forget, we will still be doing the stations of the cross on Friday at 5:15 pm. the next two weeks, and our world famous fish fry from 5 until 8. On Good Friday we will have the Fish Fry from 4 until 7.

Finally, I am sure you are all dying to know what the schedule is going to be for Holy Week, so here it is: On Holy Thursday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, Mass for the Lord's Supper at St. Ignatius will begin at 6:30 pm. Adoration in the Blessed Sacrament chapel will commence immediately after the Mass and will close at Midnight. Adoration will not resume until Easter Sunday morning after the 8:00 am Mass. At Christ the Redeemer in West Bay, Mass of the Lord's Supper will begin at 7:00 pm. On Good Friday, March 21<sup>st</sup>, we have stations of the cross starting at 12:00 noon, followed by the Good Friday service at 1:00 pm at both St. Ignatius and Christ the Redeemer. On Saturday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Easter Vigil Mass will take place at 7:00 pm at St. Ignatius only. On Easter Sunday Mass will be at 8:00 am, 11:30 am and 6:00 pm at St. Ignatius. At Christ the Redeemer, Mass will begin at 9:45 am and at 11:30 am.

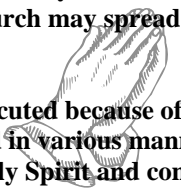

## TODAY'S GOSPEL : John 9:1-41

As he walked along, he saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" Jesus answered, "neither this man nor his parents sinned; he was born blind so that God's works might be revealed in him.

John's gospel is shot through with imagery of light and darkness. In itself this imagery is open to being used in very facile ways, but John's use of it is complex and paradoxical. In today's reading, the blind receives his physical sight, but at a deeper level he also receives spiritual sight; whereas the Pharisees who thought they had spiritual sight become increasingly spiritually blind.

"I once was lost but now I'm found/ Was blind but now I see," says the hymn Amazing Grace. We sense something presumptuous about this; it seems rather too clear-cut. Are you sure there is no darkness in you still? In reality we see and don't see. "I believe; help my unbelief!" cried the father of the child in Mark 9:24. In the story of St. Paul's conversion (Acts 9) the same paradox is evident. Paul did not leap up shouting joyfully, "Now I see!" Instead he was struck blind! Nor was it a case of being dazzled for a moment; he remained blind for three days. This mighty man had to be led by the hand like a child into Damascus and there he sat helpless, in darkness, for three days until someone else—a total stranger—restored his sight. Even then he did not go about shouting "Now I see!" He went into the Arabian desert for three years. And even later, when he was in full spate, he could write, "Now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known" (1 Corinthians 1:12)
