From the Pulpit

I am sure you are all wondering with great excitement what name did we come up with for the gift shop, and who is the winner of the 'Name the Gift Shop' contest. First, I must say that we did have a good number of excellent entries. For example, "Happy Bookstore", which was submitted by our youngest contestant, J.J. Ursua. There was also some other creative entries like, "Trinity Caboose" by Ina Augustine, and "Angels Crossing" by Deborah Kirkconnell. But the one the Parish Council decided to go with is (drum roll please): "The Grotto Gift Shop" submitted by Anita Wheaton. It totally makes sense, with the Grotto being located near the gift shop. Thank you to all the contestants with your excellent suggestions, I really appreciate everyone's input, and congratulations to Anita for winning the "Name the Gift Shop Contest."

Last Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, we picked the names at random from our list of nominees for Parish Council at the 8:00 am Mass. I was impressed with the very large number of nominees we had. I have to admit, I have never seen in any parish, so many people willing to serve on Parish Council. This is a good sign. If you weren't there at the Mass where we selected the names, here are the new Parish Council members starting in September: The Senior representative is Harvey Stephenson, and the alternate in case he can't serve is Dennison Tibbetts. The Youth representative is Taylor Wight, with the alternate being Stephen Chin. The two representatives from Christ the Redeemer in West Bay are Joe Otu and Gloria Gall with the alternate being Tony Catalanoto. And the four St. Ignatius at-large representatives are Raphael Fercol, Barbara Gee, Christine Solly and Charles MacNeil. The alternates are Derek Lee Pack, JD Mosley-Matchett and Claudette Mundle. Thanks again to all who generously offered to serve the parish in this capacity.

As Pastor of St. Ignatius, one of the things that I believe is important for me to do is to get involved in the community here on this island. As a result, I started attending the Cayman Ministers Association (CMA) meetings and getting to know the other pastors on the island. So far, it has been a good experience, and they have welcomed me with open arms to the ministers association. One of the projects that the CMA is presently working on is an all week prayer vigil called: Pray 2008. So from May 22nd until May 31st various churches will sponsor a day of prayer in their church. I signed us up for Thursday, May 29th at 7 pm until Friday, May 30th at 7 pm. That Friday, the 30th, also happens to be the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Because the Sacred Heart is a Solemnity, technically it begins on the evening before. Therefore, Thursday evening and Friday all day is counted as the solemnity. That being the case, what a great time this would be for all of us to spend a little extra time in prayer. Seeing that we already have people signed up to pray all day in our adoration chapel, I knew this wouldn't be hard for us to do. I also know that that evening, we will have a prayer group in the chapel from midnight to 3 am. All I really need then to cover this entire 24 hours of prayer is for a volunteer or two to come for sometime between 3 am and 6 am. I have already said that I would be willing to take an hour within this time frame. Another great thing about this is that we can conclude our 24 hours of prayer with the regular Mass that is scheduled for 6:00 pm on Friday.

If you would like to come and pray during our sponsored time for Pray 2008, I would highly encourage it. The ministers suggested that some things that we would like to pray for is for an evangelistic thrust on island to move people closer to Jesus Christ, for greater unity, for repentance, for marriage and family, for youth and for leaders in government and business. If you would also like to pray to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and do a devotion to the Sacred Heart, I would encourage that as well. Certainly repentance fits well within the theme of the Sacred Heart. So please think about it, and try to make the time if at all possible to spend some time in prayer in our adoration chapel in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and in union with the Christians on our island.

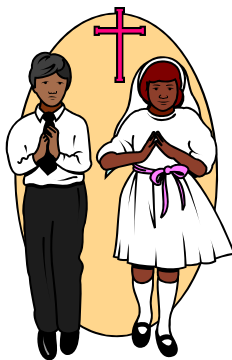

Sunday's Reflections

This Week....

The Trinity is a mystery, impossible to fully understand. So we often speak in analogy or try to use words that reflect a unified threesome. God our Maker is indeed a God of compassion and forgiveness. In the Gospel, John pulls together the relationship of God, our compassionate and forgiving maker, with Jesus the Son who is also God and our Redeemer. And Paul, in the second reading refers to God as Maker, Jesus and the Holy Spirit together in his greeting in the name of God Trinity.

For Your Reflection...

The second reading is like a greeting card from Paul. It is a note of encouragement and love. In Paul's day they don't have a "smiley faces" that say, "Have a nice day" but Paul still cares enough to send the very best. He sends greetings and blessings in the name of God as Trinity-our Creator, our Savior Jesus, and the spirit they share. We share in the holy and divine Spirit whenever we greet and bless one another. When was the last time you sent someone a greeting card that your parents didn't make you send? When was the last time you received a card that wasn't Christmas or birthday card? Prayer is like a greeting card to God and from God. Greeting cards do not create love and friendship between people, but they are a channel that feelings and thoughts can be shared and expressed more easily. What feelings and thoughts does God express to you? How do you know? What feelings and thoughts do you express to God? How do you do it?
