## From the Pulpit

Many of you are aware I am sure that this Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter, is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. The church recently instituted this feast day, based upon St. Faustina's private revelations, for the outpouring of God's grace and mercy on us. To do the Divine Mercy devotion one must first go to confession. If you have been to confession within the last 20 days, that is sufficient provided that you do not have any grave sins since you last confessed. You must also receive the Eucharist on Divine Mercy Sunday, and then attend the prayers and devotions if possible, which will be offered here at St. Ignatius starting at 2:30 pm. Basically, the prayers and devotions we will be doing is adoration and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. If you don't know it, it is o.k., we will have handouts. Those who do this devotion are promised an "ocean of grace from the font of Jesus' Divine mercy." This devotion is also to be used to obtain grace and mercy for other souls that are in need of it as well. Therefore, prayer for others is also encouraged. I welcome any and all people to attend this devotion on Sunday, it is something that is definitely good for the soul.

Once again, this year the Cayman Ministers Association (CMA) is sponsoring a week of continuous prayer, called 'Pray 2009.' This is going to last from Thursday evening, April 30<sup>th</sup>, until Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup>. I signed us up to cover the first day from 7:00 pm April 30<sup>th</sup>, until 7:00 pm May 1<sup>st</sup>. I know we are already covered for the hours that we have Mass and the hours that people are scheduled for adoration. Therefore, if I am not mistaken, we just need to make sure that the early morning hours between 3 am and 6:00 am are covered. Hopefully, we will find some volunteers.

The purpose of this 'Pray 2009' in large part is to strengthen the spiritual life of our island. It was also suggested by the CMA that we should pray for our upcoming election. I would also like to add one other thing that would be good for us to pray for: A pro-life organization, St. Michael the Archangel Organization, is trying to organize one million rosaries to be prayed between May 1<sup>st</sup> and May 3<sup>rd</sup> for the expressed intention of an end to the killing of unborn human persons. Our "prayer-a-thon" offers us a great opportunity to participate in such an endeavor. There will be a sign up sheet at the back of church, so if you would like to participate in praying the rosary for the unborn, please make sure you sign your name and how many rosaries you intend to pray. Once the list is complete, we will send off the registration as a parish.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION

### Gospel Summary

Because they did not understand all that Jesus had told them, the disciples were huddled together, frightened, in a room. The doors locked, notwithstanding, Jesus entered the room and greeted the disciples with a sign of peace. Some have interpreted this sign of peace as more than the "all be well with you," variety but more of the 'shalom' type which entails a perfect harmony with God. In any case, the disciples received the Holy Spirit and came to understand the peace Jesus intended. The authority and power to forgive sins was also given to the Church at that time. It happened that Thomas was not with the disciples when Jesus appeared, but the following week, Jesus returned and Thomas was present. He would only believe what he had heard about Jesus' appearance if he could touch the wounds in Jesus' body. Jesus invited Thomas to do so, but also told him that the people who believed without seeing or touching were truly blessed.

### Reflection for Families

Our children often come to us frightened about one thing or another. It is our job to calm their fears and generally we do a pretty good job. But sometimes, our doubts or concerns are the same as theirs. When this happens, we're not always sure how to answer them. And after reading today's gospel, we may think that our faith is not strong enough. But doubt does not necessarily mean a lack of faith. Sometimes the best we can do is tell our children that we wonder about the same things they do and then together think about how our faith help us answer the concern. Generally, these conversations revolve around a serious illness or death or death in the family and what happens when we die. It's not 'lack of faith' that causes us to not know. It is a lack of knowledge because, it's true, none of us knows exactly.

### Bringing the Gospel into Your Family

Since this gospel passage reminds us that the Church received the power to forgive our sins, this might be a good time to talk about reconciliation as a family and how receiving forgiveness from one another or through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, helps us heal and grow. If your family did not celebrate the sacrament during Lent, this might be a good time to go to Reconciliation as a family.
