Speaking of Mothers Day, it makes total sense that since we honor our Mothers this time of year, that we should also honor our Mother Mary during this month. Now some people might ask, "How is that you can say that Mary is my mother?" In answer to this question, Pope John Paul II once wrote that, "Mary's maternity has its beginning in her maternal care for Christ. In Christ, she accepted John beneath the cross, and , in him, she accepted every human and all humanity. Mary embraces all with a particular solicitude in the Holy Spirit."
