September 13, 2009– Twenty Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the Pulpit

This Monday we celebrate the feast day of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, sometimes also known as the Triumph of the Cross. The origin of this feast day dates back to the finding of the True Cross of Christ by Constantine's mother, St. Helena around the year 320 A.D., and the subsequent dedication of a basilica on the site of Golgotha on this date in 335 A.D. It was the Emperor Constantine who erected a round church called the Anastasis which was located above the empty grave of Jesus; a basilica, called the Martyrium; and in the square between the two churches, a shrine, called Calvarium, which marked the place of the crucifixion. They were eventually destroyed by the Persians in 614 A.D. The present church of the Holy Sepulcher was built by the Crusaders in 1149 A.D.

In the Eastern Church, the feast is marked by veneration of the cross through elevation and blessings in the directions of the four compass points. In Rome, a procession from St. Mary Major to St. John Lateran precedes a veneration of the cross before Mass.

The day after the feast of the Triumph of the Cross, is another important liturgical date which we will celebrate on Tuesday. Our Lady of Sorrows always occurs on the 15th of September, the day after the Exaltation of the Cross. Just as we recall Christ's passion and death, it is also appropriate to remember how Mary also suffered with her son Jesus. Therefore, the title, Our Lady of Sorrows, pertains to the spiritual martyrdom of Mary, most especially in the Passion and death of her son. The official number of known sorrows of Mary was fixed at seven by the fourteenth century. These are: The circumcision of Jesus in the Temple, the flight into Egypt, Jesus being lost in Jerusalem, the encounter with Jesus on the way to Calvary, the crucifixion, the taking of the body down from the cross, and Jesus' burial.

These two feast days truly delve into important parts of our spirituality because when it comes down to it, the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ is the central core of our faith. When we reflect on the events these feast days recall, it helps us to appreciate and understand a little better the essence of what we believe as Christians. Therefore, I encourage you not to let these two days go by without at least reflecting on them. And just so that you know, because the Exaltation of the Holy Cross is an important Feast day, we are scheduling a second Mass on Monday the 14th at 6:00 pm. So if you can't make it to Mass at 7:00 am Monday, but would still like to be able to go to Mass, perhaps 6:00 pm will work for you.

SCHOLARSHIP APPEAL – A new school year has begun! The St. Ignatius/Dorothy Rice Scholarship Fund has been in existence for thirteen years. The fund was created to allow eligible students to continue receiving a Catholic Education. The annual fees at St. Ignatius are nearly \$8000 per student.
