From the Pulpit

I would personally like to thank the men of our Catholic Men's Fellowship group who put on our 1st annual bar-b-que picnic. It takes a lot of work and effort to put something like that together, and I think everyone who came will agree, a great time was had by all. In addition, the food was absolutely delicious. I must have gained 3 pounds that day. If you didn't make it this time, don't worry, it was such a huge success that we plan on doing it again next year, so be sure not to miss out on all the fun.

I wanted to also remind you that there still are spaces available for the mission trip to Jamaica in March. If you are interested please see the bulletin insert. You can also call the office for more details.

As many of you know, I traveled to St. Lucia last week. I went there for the Pontifical Mission Society Conference. Every year, all the diocesan directors in the Caribbean get together to discuss what they have done and what they are planning on doing to support the Pontifical Mission charities in their diocese. Although the Cayman Islands are not a diocese in and of itself, we are still nonetheless a participating member of the Caribbean Antilles dioceses. Therefore, I came to St. Lucia representing the Cayman Islands and gave a power point presentation on what we have done and what we are going to do in the next year for the building up of the church through these charities. The conference in St. Lucia was located at the Benedictine Abbey near the Castries. It was a beautiful setting.

Just so that you know, there are four Pontifical Mission societies, or charities if you will. They are: The Society for the Propagation of the faith, which is the mission Sunday collection that we do every October. There is the Society of Saint Peter Apostle, which is different from Peter's Pence. There is the Society of Holy Childhood and the Missionary Union of Clergy. We also do report on the other collections that go to Rome which are the Holy Land collection and Peter's Pence, but these are not, strictly speaking, under the umbrella of the Pontifical Missionary Societies.

While in St. Lucia, not only did we all give our reports and attend lectures and informational sessions, but we also had a chance to visit some of the Catholic schools that have received support from these charities (societies) that you so generously give money to. I can honestly say with first hand knowledge that your money is going to good use. It was especially good to see the children greet us with song as we visited their school. Also, just so that you know, the money that we raised for relief in Haiti at church, half of it is being sent through Catholic Relief Services, and the other half is being sent through the Pontifical Mission Societies. These charities are well run and do great work. And so in the future, when we take up collections for them in the future, I again encourage you to continue your support for the sake of the poor and the building up of the church around the world.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Starting next Friday evening at 5:15pm we will have the Stations of the Cross at St. Ignatius Church. Christ the Redeemer will start with the rosary at 7pm followed by the Stations of the Cross. All are invited to join in this very special traditional Catholic prayer.

The object of the Stations is to help all of us to make in spirit, as it were, a pilgrimage to the chief scenes of Christ's sufferings and death. This has become one of the most popular of Catholic devotions.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Next Sunday, February 21 is the 1st Sunday of Lent. At the 8am Mass we will have the Rite of Election and the Rite of the Call to Continuing Conversion with our 12 Candidates for RCIA this year.

The **Rite of Election** is a significant step for those who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. Election in our contemporary culture often signifies a contest or our choosing something or somebody. The Rite of Election is not about the candidates choosing the Sacraments of Initiation, rather, as in the great scriptural tradition of election, it is about God's choice of the person. For Christians this is the call to embrace the mission of Jesus, the mission of God's Kingdom.

In the **Rite of the Call to Continuing Conversion**, the Church welcomes those who are already baptized and are preparing to complete their initiation through both Confirmation and Eucharist and to be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. The Church acknowledges their desire to be one with the Church in faith, prayer and service. Respecting the integrity of their baptism, the Church charges these candidates to use the Lenten season as a time to hear again the call to conversion and to be faithful to their baptismal vows.
