From the Pulpit

Here in Cayman, this month is designated as child abuse prevention month. It is a sad reality that child abuse is a problem that exists throughout our society today. But fortunately, there are prevention programs that are available today. I am sure you would be happy to know that from our end, the Archdiocese of Detroit is proactive in this regard and has shown its commitment in promoting "Safe Environments" in every parish, including our own, St. Ignatius. During the most recent reporting period, from July 1, 2008 – June 30, 2009, the archdiocese held 124 "Protecting God's Children" workshops and trained 6,195 adults. To date, 56,000 adults have completed the required training. Here at St. Ignatius, 192 adults and 755 children have received the training. This includes parish and school staff members, adult and teenage volunteers, and students.

The Archdiocese of Detroit also wants everyone to be aware that there is a number to call for those who wish to report clerical sex abuse cases. That number is: (248) 548-4044 ext. 3303. Messages left are returned in a timely manner. Reports can also be made via mail to "The Archbishop's Review Board Delegate, Archdiocese of Detroit, 1234 Washington Blvd., Detroit, MI. 48226, USA. Furthermore, there is internet-posted information on reporting, the archdiocesan policy, case status reports, etc., at www.AODonline.org/safeenvironments.

There is no time limit or restriction on bringing a complaint forward. If the complaint involves an incident from 20 months ago or 20 years ago, the archdiocese wants to hear about it. Every complaint the archdiocese receives is immediately turned over to the appropriate law enforcement authorities. If the authorities investigate, the archdiocese cooperates fully with them. Regardless of what action civil authorities take, the Archdiocesan Review Board also considers the complaint. If deemed credible, the Board commences an investigation. Subsequent to the investigation, the Board makes a recommendation to the archbishop.

Besides the program that we continue to offer here at St. Ignatius, there is another group, J Jireh Hands of Hope, who are also offering a workshop for the prevention of child abuse. The workshop is called, "Darkness to Light, Stewards of Children." This workshop will be offered on Tuesday, April 27th, Wednesday the 28th, and Thursday the 29th from 7:00 – 9:30 pm. This workshop is open to anyone who has an interest. It will be conducted at the J Jireh Hands of Hope office at Savannah Plaza, Hirst Road Unit # 5. You can also call Sylvia Wilks at 947-5742 for more information.

It is important to realize that if we are all vigilant and take seriously the problem of child abuse, we can together make a difference in preventing it from occurring. That is why we raise awareness of this issue by discussing what is actually being done to prevent it, because in the end it is for the sake of our children.
