Dear Parishioners of St. Ignatius and Christ the Redeemer,

Happy Easter! The Lord is risen!

I hope that you are all well.

Things are going well here in South Texas thanks be to God. We have been very blessed with Easter rains, and the earth is blooming with wild flowers, a shower of color, a sign of the resurrection. This time last year we were in the midst of one of the worst droughts on record and now in the year of the priest the land is lush, every plant and animal is thriving. Our heavenly Father has blessed us tremendously with these spring showers. We have been in the process, over the last six weeks, of planting out all the trees in our nursery and so far we have not had to water once, something which would have been inconceivable last year, not only with the drought but with the early heat as well.

Every thing around us speaks of new life, and points us, as nature should according to St. Paul, towards God. In the Easter season we must leave the drought of our old lives behind and live in the resurrection, rejoice with Our Lady that her Son is alive, shout alleluia with the souls that were released from the dead when Christ came to them. Can the work of the resurrection, of the fifty days of Easter, be greater than that of Lent? Possibly, for the work that is given to us at this time is one of rejoicing. And this does take some effort. We must open ourselves and allow ourselves to be suffused with the grace of God, to dwell in the heart of the resurrection, which is the heart of the Trinity. We must *choose* to dwell there, and *choose* not to allow ourselves to be bogged down in the cares of the world. Our Father's grace is sufficient for this. Christ says in St. Johns' gospel, that whoever "does accept his (Christ's) testimony, certifies that God is trustworthy". Do we certify that God is trustworthy? Jesus tells His disciples, that after the resurrection, when He sees them again, "your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy away from you." Surely we believe that God is trustworthy, that he will fulfill the promise of joy that He made to the disciples of Jesus Christ? Let's live what we profess we believe! Is rejoicing still a daunting task? Give your hearts to Our Lady. Where she is, so is her spouse the Holy Spirit, the giver of all good gifts (Lk 11:13). The Father sent Jesus to us through her and it is His intention that we go back through her to the Trinity. She will draw us all up into the very heart of the Trinity where all hearts over flow with great joy at participating in the love that the Divine persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit have for one another and for the whole world.

I just wanted to send a little letter thanking everyone in Cayman for your help and encouragement and to let all of you know that you are in our prayers. May almighty God bless, and keep you all and may all of you remain under the protection of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity.
