## From the Pulpit

When Pope John XXIII convened the Second Vatican Council, his hope was for what he called a “New Pentecost” in our time. On this Pentecost Sunday we would do well to reflect on the mystery of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church today.

If it were not for the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit, the Church could not survive. Just look at the disciples for example. It wasn't until they received the Holy Spirit before they could go out and boldly proclaim the good news of the risen Lord. Human weakness, being what it is, can only be overcome with the help of God's Spirit. Very often, Christ's followers are a persecuted minority, as they were through much of the past century in Eastern Europe, and still are in places like China or Sudan.

In the words of Bishop Blair, the bishop of the Toledo diocese, “Even in our Western society, there is a tremendous pressure to abandon faith and morals in the name of pluralism and tolerance. Sadly, many Catholics are Catholic in name only, having reduced their faith to some vague allegiance or identity without coherent content...One has only to read the New Testament to realize that a comfortable Christianity which “goes along to get along” is not what Jesus preached.”

Jesus came to give us truth so that we might believe and have life. The Holy Spirit enables us to live that truth out. The “New Pentecost” which Pope John XXIII hoped for is this world's transformation in Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us then, implore the gift of the Spirit so that we may have the courage of the apostles to live out our faith and live in the light and the truth of Jesus our Lord.
