## From the Pulpit

This Friday is the feast day of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. As a result, we will be doing the consecration to the Sacred Heart devotion in addition to benediction after the 6:00 pm Mass that evening. The history of this devotion is rather interesting. In the ancient church during the Patristic period, the Holy Spirit was seen as flowing out upon the Church from Jesus' pierced side as he hung upon the cross. But during the Middle Ages, a shift occurred from the wound in Jesus' side as being a source of grace, to the heart of Jesus. The heart was seen as the seat of a person's inner life. As a result, Christ's three-fold love – human, infused and divine – is epitomized by the pierced heart of Jesus hanging on the cross. Couple this with a popular piety that emphasized Christ's passion, and it is easy to see why devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus came about.

This devotion was eventually taken on and spread further by the founder of the Jesuits (None other than St. Ignatius of Loyola himself; 1491-1556) and the Sisters of the Visitation (St. Francis de Sales; 1567-1622). John Eudes (1601-1680) composed a Mass and Office of the Sacred Heart, and then the private revelations of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) did much to promote and spread the devotion further and shape its practice. In 1765, the bishops of Poland were allowed to celebrate a feast of the Sacred Heart, which was then extended to the universal Church in 1856.

This devotion consists of venerating Jesus' physical heart, united to his divinity, as being the symbol of his redemptive love. That is why this devotion is so important, its because we need to be reminded of God's love more than ever – His deep, profound, limitless abyss of love. There are many people who don't see or understand this characteristic of God, and yet if they did, they would cling to God with great fervor and joy. Therefore, I encourage anyone and everyone to take part in this special devotion.

The next day after the Sacred Heart of Jesus of course is the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This devotion was also promoted by John Eudes, who is the one credited to linking this devotion with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In a similar way to the Sacred Heart, devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary is a reminder of Mary's interior life: Her joys and sorrows, her virtues and her virginal love for God, for her divine Son, and for us. Mass for the Immaculate Heart of Mary will be at 8:30 am on Saturday. All are welcome to attend.
