Happy 60th Anniversary!

As we celebrate 60 years as a church community, it is always interesting to reflect on how different things were when our faith community began.

The world population in 1950 was 2.5 billion, today it is over 6 billion. In Cayman, the population in 1950 was 6,000, we now have around 60,000. There were of course no cell phones, microwave ovens, personal computers, dvds, cds, blackberries, internet or digital anything . The first credit cards appeared in the United States in 1950. These cards were Diners cards and American Express, and both required full payment at the end of the month.

The #1 song in the U.S. the first week in January in 1950 was “Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer” by Gene Autry, and the top grossing film that year by far was Walt Disney’s “Cinderella.” Yes, times certainly have changed.

The monarch in the U.K. in 1950 was King George VI.

In 1950, the Cayman Islands were relatively unknown to the rest of the world. In the Cayman Islands, there was no airfield, just sea plane service. There was also no hospital. Very few people had cars and the majority of people did not have electricity. For those who did have electricity, it was sporadic. And then of course there was the mosquitoes. I’m sure everyone has heard the stories of how numerous they were, how animals sometimes suffocated on them because there were so many, that people had to use smoke pots to keep the mosquitoes away and that one couldn’t really go out in the evening because of them.

Who knows what the next 60 years will bring? Clearly the changes that have come to this faith community, our islands and the world is huge. And yet through it all the Catholic Church has grown and thrived here in Cayman through the hard work and dedication of the Catholics who have lived here over the years. It is with that same spirit of faith and determination that we need to continue to move forward amid the many changes that will most assuredly take place. In our 60 years of existence, we have met many challenges. With hope, optimism and hard work, we can keep that faith alive and growing so that more and more people may come to know and experience God’s saving love.
