## October 31, 2010– Thirty First Sunday in Ordinary Time

### Mission Sunday

The Church has set apart one Sunday in the Month of October as the **“Mission Sunday”**. This is an occasion to reflect on, how faithful we have been to the command of Christ in proclaiming the Good News, sharing the greatest treasure we possess: our faith in Christ.

Through the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, we all have received the outpouring of the Spirit and Christ entrusted to us the same mission that he had entrusted to His Apostles: **“Proclaim the Good News; proclaim to everyone and proclaim it all the times”**

The task of spreading the Gospel is not something that we can take or leave at will; it is a strict duty for us all, both as individuals and as a community. The gift of faith that we received at Baptism is not only a privilege but also a responsibility to share it with others.

We can do this by becoming active missionaries-by leaving our home and country and going out to unknown places and people; or we can carry out this responsibility by prayer, sacrifice and offering our time, talent and treasure.

Christ is The Missionary par excellence. The Father sent Him to this world on a threefold mission of teaching, preaching and healing. He walked the highways and byways of Palestine, preaching the Good News: in the synagogues, on the hilltops, in fishermen's boats and finally He walked up the rugged hill of Calvary and preached His Last Seven Words from the Cross.

You and I have to preach Jesus Christ wherever we are, for the Church teaches: **“There is no true evangelization, if the Name, the Teaching, the Life, the Promises, the Kingdom and the Mystery of Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God are not proclaimed”**.

**“How beautiful are the feet of those who carry the Good News!”**
